THIS WEEK'S SERIES: St. Cloud State University continues its Western Collegiate Hockey Association schedule with a home series against the University of Wisconsin Badgers (5-0-1, 1-0-1 WCHA) on

Friday and Saturday, Oct. 19-20. Both games of the WCHA tilt are set for 7:07 p.m. in the National Hockey Center.

2007-08 RECORD: The Huskies are 1-2-1 overall and 1-2-1 in the WCHA.

IN THE NHC: The Huskies have posted a 62-85-10 overall home record since 1998.

ON THE ROAD: SCSU has an all-time road record of 40-92-12 since 1998, and a neutral record of 1-4-0.

VOTES IN THE POLLS: St. Cloud State women's hockey received four votes in the USCHO.com Division I Poll released on Oct. 15, and two votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Women's College Hockey Poll released on Oct. 16. The last time the Huskies made the polls was on Sept. 19, 2006, when SCSU received two votes in the USCHO.com Preseason Poll.

WALKING IN NUMBERS: SCSU women's student-athletes hosted a Walking in Numbers athletic scholarship fundraiser on Sunday, Oct. 14. St. Cloud State alumni, friends, boosters, and community members were invited to meet the SCSU athletes and join them in their walk. The event ran from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. in Halenbeck South Field House on the SCSU campus.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: On Saturday, Oct. 13, the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team made history in the National Hockey Center as it defeated the No. 6/7 Minnesota Gophers by a score of 2-1. This 2007-08 Husky squad became the first team in school history to not be defeated by Minnesota in a weekend series after notching a 4-4 overtime tie against the Gophers on Friday, Oct. 12, in Ridder Arena.

SCSU'S HEAD COACH

JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen is in his second season as the head coach of the SCSU women's hockey program in 2007-08. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen served as the SCSU assistant women's hockey coach from 2003-2006,

working with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. He came to SCSU from Saint John's University, where he was an assistant coach from 1992-98 and an associate head coach from 1998-2003. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on September 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their daughter Delaney.

JASON JOHNSON: Jason Johnson joins the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007-08 after serving as an assistant men's hockey coach at nearby Saint John's University since 2003 under the helm of head coach John Harrington, a former SCSU men's assistant coach and Olympic Gold Medalist. During Johnson's coaching years at SJU, the Johnnies won back-to-back Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

(MIAC) titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. No stranger to the game of hockey, Johnson played four years at Saint John's and tallied 59 points (27g, 32a) in 95 career games played for the Johnnies. His senior season, SJU finished third at the 1997 Division III National Tournament. Johnson's responsibilities at St. Cloud State include recruiting, video breakdown and working with the defensemen. For the past nine years, Johnson has been a first grade teacher at the Albertville Primary School. A resident of St. Michael and 2003 graduate of Hamline University with a master's of arts in education, Johnson and his wife Rachel have two sons, JP and Jack.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., begins her second season on the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007. Prior to joining the Husky staff in 2006, Kranz served as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No

stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12g, 10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a bachelor's of arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. Kranz served as the Team Leader at the girls' 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, NY, in 2005 and in Rochester, NY, in 2006. This past summer, Kranz served as a Team Coach for the girls' 15's USA Player Development camp in St. Cloud, Minn. She has also been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT:

No. 1 WISCONSIN (October 19-20)

The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team continues its WCHA schedule with a home series against the two-time national defending champions, the University of Wisconsin Badgers, on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 19-20...both games of the WCHA tilt are set for 7:07 p.m. in the National Hockey Center...UW is 5-0-1 overall and 1-0-1 in the WCHA in 2007-08...Wisconsin leads the all-time series 28-4-2, dating back to the 1999-2000 season...in the last 10 meetings between the Badgers and the Huskies, UW owns a 7-1-2 mark...last season, SCSU went 0-2-2 against the Badgers, including a pair of ties at SCSU on Dec. 8-9, 2006, in the NHC...Wisconsin, ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com poll (10.15.07) and the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll (10.16.07), has been ranked in 127 consecutive USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine polls and 118 USCHO.com polls (as of 10.16.07)...the Badgers have set a new NCAA record for the longest unbeaten streak in Division I women's hockey at 32 games, going 28-0-4 in that stretch.



UW's Head Coach Mark Johnson

BADGERS TO WATCH: First year forward Mallory Deluce leads the team with five goals and shares the team lead with seven points. Deluce tallied the game-winning goal on Oct. 13 and the game-tying goal on Oct. 14 against Ohio State. Angie Keseley, a junior forward, is the second Badger with seven points (4g, 3a) in 2007-08, as are first year Hilary Knight (2g, 5a) and senior Jinelle Zaugg (2g, 5a). Second on the team is sophomore forward, Meghan Duggan, who has notched two goals and four assists this season. Junior goaltender Jessie Vetter leads the Badgers with a 0.59 GAA and a .951 save percentage. Last weekend, Vetter posted her 18th career shutout against OSU, tying the school record set by former Badger Christine Dufour last season.

UW HEAD COACH MARK JOHNSON: With strong ties to Wisconsin as a coach's son, player and assistant coach, Mark Johnson stepped into the role of head women's hockey coach beginning with the 2002-03 season. In five seasons, Johnson and the Wisconsin women's hockey team have continued to shatter both school and national records. Johnson, the 2006 and 2007 American Hockey Coaches Association Division I Coach of the Year, has led the Badgers to back-to-back WCHA regular season, playoff and NCAA championships while winning more games in a two-year period (72) than any other team in women's college hockey history.

During the 2006-07 campaign, Johnson's team broke or tied 18 NCAA team and individual records including wins in a season (36), fewest losses (one), best winning percentage (.927) and most shutouts (18). Johnson leads all active women's college hockey coaches with a winning percentage of .815 after compiling an impressive record of 147-28-14 in his five years at Wisconsin.

Johnson's impact on women's hockey has extended well beyond Madison in large part due to his involvement with USA Hockey. During the 2006-07 season alone, Johnson led the U.S. women's national team at the 2007 IIHF World Women's Championship in Winnipeg, Manitoba as well as the 2006 Four Nations Cup in Kitchener, Ontario.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

LAST TIME IN OT: The Huskies posted a 4-4 overtime tie against Minnesota on Friday, Oct. 12, in Ridder Arena (Minneapolis). The last time SCSU played in overtime was on Feb. 9, 2007 at Minnesota State, when the Huskies suffered a 3-4 loss in All-Seasons Arena.

THE FIRST TIE: SCSU skated to the first tie in school history against Minnesota on Friday, Oct. 12, in Ridder Arena. The Huskies posted a 4-4 tie, which brought the all-time series between SCSU and the Gophers to 33-1-1, with UM leading the series. After the Husky 2-1 win on Saturday, Oct. 13, the Gophers lead the all-time series 33-2-1.

HELP AWAY HIRSCH: Sophomore defender Danielle Hirsch had a career weekend against Minnesota on Oct. 12-13, as she doubled her career point total with three helpers against the Gophers. The Bloomington, Minn., native now has six career assists in 39 games played. Of note, Hirsch led the Huskies with a +/- of +3 against the Gophers.

POWER PLAY FOR PEZON:

SCSU's Meaghan Pezon scored two power play goals and one assist in the weekend home-and-home series against the No. 6/7 Minnesota Gophers on Oct. 12-13, which resulted in SCSU taking three-of-four points from Minnesota. On Friday night, in the 4-4 tie at Ridder Arena, Pezon posted one goal and one assist, and she came up even bigger on Saturday, after charting the game-winner with just over nine minutes to go in the third period. Originally from Eden Prairie, Minn., Pezon ranks 24th all-time at SCSU with 26 points (14g, 12a) in 41 games played.

THREE CHEERS FOR ROBERTS: Holly Roberts, SCSU's sophomore forward from St. Cloud, Minn., also had three points against Minnesota last weekend. Roberts charted a goal and two assists, as the Huskies became the first team ever to survive a weekend series against WCHA rival Minnesota without a defeat.

NEWELL IN NET: Senior goaltender Kendall Newell led SCSU with 125:00 minutes played, 62 saves (.925) and a 2.40 GAA against Minnesota. Originally from Phoenix, Ariz., Newell tied the school's all-time record for ties in a career with six on Friday, Oct. 12, after collecting a 4-4 overtime tie between the pipes. Former Husky goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (2003-2007) set the initial record, and completed her SCSU career with an overall record of 26-45-6. Newell's current career record stands at 13-15-6.
