2006-07 SCSU WOMEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

HUSKY HOMECOMING: The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (1-4-1, 0-4-0 WCHA) returns home for SCSU's Homecoming Weekend with a two-game Western Collegiate Hockey Association series against the Ohio State University Buckeyes (2-2-0, 0-2-0 WCHA) on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 20-21, in the National Hockey Center. The Huskies WCHA home-opener on Friday is scheduled for 7:07 p.m., and the puck is set to be dropped at 2:07 p.m. on Saturday for the second game of the series.

2006-07 SEASON RECORD: The Huskies are 1-4-1 overall and 0-4-0 in the WCHA in 2006-07. Since 1998, SCSU has posted an overall record of 91-165-15 and a 53-116-11 mark in the WCHA.

SKATE WITH THE HUSKIES: St. Cloud State University's annual "Skate With the Huskies" program will take place from 6 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 22. Fans will get an opportunity to skate on the ice at the National Hockey Center with members of the 2006-07 men's and women's hockey teams from SCSU. This event is open to the public and admission is free. For more information, please call the National Hockey Center office at 320-308-3327.

SCSU AT HOME: The 2006-07 SCSU women's hockey team is 1-0-1 in the National Hockey Center. Since 1998, the Huskies have posted a 56-77-7 overall home record.

A NEW CHAPTER HAS BEGUN: A new chapter has begun in the SCSU women's hockey program with Jeff Giesen taking over as head coach in 2006-07. Giesen tallied his first career win on Friday, Sept. 29th, with a 4-0 shutout victory over Robert Morris University in the National Hockey Center. The Huskies are coming off their most successful season in school history in 2005-06. SCSU finished 18-18-1 overall and finished in fourth place in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) with a 13-14-1 conference record.

ON THE RADIO: The SCSU women's hockey team can be heard live on KVSC 88.1 FM on Friday, Oct. 27, against Minnesota Duluth. Sports director John Hadden and the KVSC sports department will broadcast numerous games throughout the season.

LIVE STATS: St. Cloud State women's hockey fans can enjoy live stats on the web for all Husky home games in 2006-07. Live Stats can be viewed by going to the Husky athletics home page at www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics and following the directions.

TICKET INFORMATION: Tickets for the women's hockey home games are \$6 for adults and \$3 for youth, ages 2 through college. SCSU student admission is free with validated ID. Tickets can be purchased the day of the game, beginning 90 minutes prior to the initial face-off. Advance single game tickets can be purchased in person at the SCSU Athletic Ticket Office located in the National Hockey Center or by phone at 320-308-2137 or 1-877-SCSUTIX.

SCSU HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN: Jeff Giesen is in his first season as the head coach of the SCSU women's hockey program in 2006-07. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen becomes the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen served as the SCSU assistant women's hockey coach from 2003-2006, working with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. He came to SCSU from Saint John's University, where he was an assistant coach from 1992-98 and an associate head coach from 1998-2003. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their daughter Delaney.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba) and Hailey Clarkson (Winnipegosis, Manitoba) will serve as the team captains for the Huskies in 2006-07. The assistant captains for this winter are senior goaltender Lauri St. Jacques (Sturgeon Fall, Ont.) and junior forward Laura Fast (Calgary, Alberta).

SCSU ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:

BRIAN IDALSKI: The former head coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Idalski brings a multitude of success to SCSU as he begins his first season as a full-time assistant to first-year head women's hockey coach Jeff Giesen. Idalski served as the head women's coach at UW-Stevens Point from 2001-2006 and posted a 108-21-11 record (.811 winning percentage) in the last five seasons. During his tenure with the Pointers, he guided his teams to an NCAA Division III national runner-up finish in 2003-04, an NCAA Division III quarterfinal showing in 2004-05 and a third place finish at the NCAA Division III Tournament in 2005-06. Leaving behind a notable list of accomplishments, Idalski charted 2002, 2005 and 2006 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association (NCHA) regular season championships and NCHA playoff championships in 2002, 2004, 2005 and 2006. A four-year letterwinner at UW-Stevens Point from 1991-1995, Idalski was a member of the Pointers' NCAA Division III runner-up team in 1992 and was a sophomore on the 1993 Division III national championship team. Playing 97 career games as a defenseman, he tallied five goals and 20 assists. Following his Pointer playing days, Idalski went on to play professional hockey for two years with the Madison Monsters of the United Hockey League from 1995-1997. He then played two seasons with the Columbus (Ga.) Cottonmouths of the Central Hockey League from 1997-1999, and won the 1998 CHL regular season and playoff championship. A Warren, Mich. native, Idalski his wife, Nicole, have four sons, Beau, Jason, David and Mitchel.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., joins the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2006 after serving as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities will include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12 g,10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a Bachelor's of Arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. During her tenure at Shattuck-St. Mary's, Kranz also served as an academic advisor for the student-athletes, and since 2004, also held the community service coordinator responsibilities for the girls' hockey program. Kranz recently served as the Team Leader at the 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, and has been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT: OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY (Oct. 20-21)

The St. Cloud State University women's hockey team returns home for Homecoming Week for a two-game series against Ohio State University...SCSU is 7-8-1 versus OSU in the National Hockey Center...in 2005-06, the Huskies took three of four points in the head-to-head series with the Buckeyes to gain home ice advantage in the first round of the WCHA playoffs and seal a fourth place finish in the WCHA regular season...SCSU hosted OSU on March 3-4, 2006, and swept the series in two games by scores of 2-1 and 6-3, to advance to the WCHA semifinals at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis...Ohio State, who received one vote in the USCHO.com poll on Oct. 16 and four votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll, leads the all-time series with St. Cloud State, 17-13-2.

UPPERCLASSMEN LEAD OSU: The Ohio State University Buckeyes have been led by their upperclassmen in 2006-07. Three Buckeyes have totaled eight points a piece, each having tallied three goals and five assists on the season. Senior defender Amber Bowman, junior defender Tessa Bonhomme and junior forward Mallory Peckels are the individuals leading in the scoring category, and all three are tied for third in the WCHA in scoring. In all, 12 OSU players have collected at least one point this season. Play between the pipes has been split between senior veteran Erika Vanderveer and sophomore Liana Bonanno. In two games played, Vanderveer has amassed 50 saves (.909) and a GAA of 2.76 with five goals against. Bonanno leads the Buckeyes with a .918 save percentage and a 2.22 GAA in 107:54 minutes of ice time. Also seeing time in goal has been junior Jill Mauch, who has played 21:41 in two games.

BUCKEYE'S HEAD COACH JACKIE BARTO: Jackie Barto, the first and only head coach of the Ohio State women's ice hockey team, is entering her eighth season at the helm of the Buckeyes. Over the past seven years, she has established Ohio State as a top university for collegiate women's hockey. Under Barto, Ohio State has posted a 102-130-24 record. She reached her 100th OSU win Jan. 28, 2006 in a 3-2 overtime win against Minnesota. Prior to the Buckeyes, Barto spent five years at Providence College and has obtained a career ledger of 172-183-34 in 12 seasons. Barto is assisted by Catherine Hanson (fifth year) and Katie Lachapelle (third year) in 2006-07.

When Was The Last Time...

FIRST-YEAR FORWARDS FOR FIFTEEN:

Four of SCSU's first year forwards have combined for 15 points in six games. Holly Roberts (St. Cloud), after tallying three points in the BSU series last weekend, leads the Huskies with five points (3g, 2a). Linemate Meaghan Pezon (Eden Prairie) has posted a team second-best four points in 2006-07, including a team-leading four goals. Katie Kemmerer (Anchorage, AK) has chipped in three points for SCSU (2g, 1a) and the fourth first-year forward to complete the 15-point total is Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale/1g, 2a), who tallied her first career goal against BSU on Oct. 14, in the John Glas Fieldhouse.

SERIES OF FIRSTS: Although the Huskies dropped both games to BSU on Oct. 13-14, a number of Huskies tallied "firsts" on the season. First year forward Meaghan Pezon (Eden Prairie) tallied her first two-goal career game on Oct. 13, and junior forward Marie Michel Lemieux (Boisbrand, Quebec) collected her first goal of the season at the 06:32 mark of the first period. On Oct. 14, first year forward Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale) charted her first career goal at 04:36 in the first period, and senior co-captain Denelle Maguet (St. Rose, Manitoba) connected on her first goal of the season with a Husky 6-on-4 advantage with a pulled goaltender in the third period.

THE LAST TIME: SCSU's Denelle Maguet scored with an extra skater against Bemidji State on Oct. 14, after junior goaltender Carmen Lizée was pulled from the ice in the third period. The last time SCSU scored with a pulled goalie/extra skater was on Jan. 14, 2005, when Kristy Oonincx scored with 00:26 remaining to tie the game at 4-4 against BSU at the NHC.

HUSKIES IN THE WCHA:

SCSU's Holly Roberts is tied for 18th in the WCHA in overall scoring (3-2-5), is tied for 6th in goal scoring (3) and is tied for fourth with two power play goals. Meaghan Pezon ranks 22nd in the WCHA with four points, and also ranks third with four goals scored on the season. Defender Brita Schroeder leads the Husky blue line with three assists, which ranks her tied for 9th in the WCHA defensemen scoring. Three more SCSU defenders, Tricia Fast, Stacy Dey and Brittni Kuyper, have each tallied two assists on the season and are tied for 14th in the WCHA in defensemen scoring.
