### THIS WEEK'S SERIES:

St. Cloud State University women's hockey (5-4-3, 4-4-2 WCHA) will head to Boston University for a non-conference series tilt on Friday and

Saturday, Nov. 16-17, in Boston, Mass. Both games will be played at the BU Agganis Arena, with Friday's game starting at 6 p.m. CT and Saturday's game slated for a 12 p.m. CT start.

**THE SERIES RECORD:** The Huskies lead the all-time series with BU, which started last season (2006-07), 1-0-1.

**2007-08 RECORD:** The Huskies are 5-4-3 overall and 4-4-2 in the WCHA.

**IN THE NHC:** The Huskies have posted a 65-86-11 overall home record since 1998.

**ON THE ROAD:** SCSU has an all-time road record of 41-93-13 since 1998, and a neutral record of 1-4-0.

#### WCHA WEEKLY HONOR:

SCSU's Sammy Nixon (Blaine) was named the WCHA Offensive Player of the Week for her efforts against North Dakota on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 9-10, in the National Hockey Center. The junior forward scored three power play goals against UND in SCSU's weekend home series. On Friday night, S.

Nixon tallied her first career two-goal game in the 3-3 overtime tie, and on Saturday, the Blaine native charted her third goal of the weekend to help lead the Huskies to a 3-1 win over UND. She fired off seven shots on the weekend and her three power play goals rank her tied for second in the league.

### SCSU's HEAD COACH

**JEFF GIESEN:** Jeff "Goose" Giesen is in his second season as the head coach of the SCSU women's hockey program in 2007-08. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen served as the SCSU assistant women's hockey coach from 2003-2006,

working with the Huskies' defensive players and recruiting. He came to SCSU from Saint John's University, where he was an assistant coach from 1992-98 and an associate head coach from 1998-2003. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on September 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 17-22-10. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their daughter Delaney.

JASON JOHNSON: Jason Johnson joins the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007-08 after serving as an assistant men's hockey coach at nearby Saint John's University since 2003 under the helm of head coach John Harrington, a former SCSU men's assistant coach and Olympic Gold Medalist. During Johnson's coaching years at SJU, the Johnnies won back-to-back Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

(MIAC) titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. No stranger to the game of hockey, Johnson played four years at Saint John's and tallied 59 points (27g, 32a) in 95 career games played for the Johnnies. His senior season, SJU finished third at the 1997 Division III National Tournament. Johnson's responsibilities at St. Cloud State include recruiting, video breakdown and working with the defensemen. For the past nine years, Johnson has been a first grade teacher at the Albertville Primary School. A resident of St. Michael and 2003 graduate of Hamline University with a master's of arts in education, Johnson and his wife Rachel have two sons, JP and Jack.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., begins her second season on the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007. Prior to joining the Husky staff in 2006, Kranz served as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No

stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12g, 10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a bachelor's of arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. Kranz served as the Team Leader at the girls' 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, NY, in 2005 and in Rochester, NY, in 2006. This past summer, Kranz served as a Team Coach for the girls' 15's USA Player Development camp in St. Cloud, Minn. She has also been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY (November 16-17)

St. Cloud State University women's hockey (5-4-3, 4-4-2 WCHA) will head to Boston University (2-6-2, 0-2-0 HE) for a non-conference series tilt on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 16-17, in Boston, Mass...both games will be played at the BU Agganis Arena, with Friday's game starting at 6 p.m. CT and Saturday's game slated for a 12 p.m. CT start...the Huskies lead the all-time series with BU, which started last season (2006-07), 1-0-1...SCSU is tied for third with Ohio State in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association standings with 10 league points...BU is 2-2-1 in its last five outings this season.

TERRIER PLAYERS TO WATCH: The University of Boston women's hockey team is led by junior forward Gina Kearns. Kearns has posted nine points in 10 games played, and leads the team with eight helpers. Three other Terriers have tallied eight points on the season.

Those players include sophomore forward Melissa Anderson (5g, 3a), junior forward Erin Seman (2g, 6a) and senior defender Julie Poulin (2g, 6a). Time in net has been split between junior goaltender Allyse Wilcox and sophomore goaltender Melissa Haber. Wilcox leads with a 2-3-1 overall record and a 1.92 goals against average in 343:32 minutes played. Haber has posted a team-best 153 saves and is 0-3-1 overall.

BU HEAD COACH BRIAN DUROCHER: Brian Durocher enters his third year as head coach for the Boston University women's ice hockey team and has the fledgling program headed for an exciting future. Durocher, who was named the first head coach for the women's varsity program on June 3, 2004, has in short time established the Terriers as a program on the rise, primed for long-term success. Durocher has instilled in his players a healthy dose of confidence, and the program has already exceeded expectations. In 2005-06, BU was picked to finish last in the Hockey East preseason poll and the Terriers ended up in sixth place, compiling an overall record of 12-17-4 and six conference victories.

A native of Longmeadow, Mass., Durocher compiled an impressive 47-13-1 career record minding the goal for the Terriers. His most successful year was his freshman season during which he compiled a 17-2-1 record with a 3.61 goals-against average and a .874 save percentage. He won the Eberly Trophy as the outstanding goalie in the Beanpot and was an All-East selection. His senior year, as the Terriers finished with a 30-2 record and won the NCAA title, he posted a 14-2-0 record, along with a 3.99 GAA and .871 save percentage.

Durocher and his wife, Laura, live in Brookline, Mass., and have three daughters, Kirsten, Kara and Kelsey.

26, 2006, in a 5-5 overtime tie at North Dakota in the Ralph Engelstad Arena. SCSU took three of four points against UND that weekend (Nov. 25-26).

On the 2007-08 season, S. Nixon is tied for the Huskies team second-best in goal scoring with five in 12 games played. This marks the first time in S. Nixon's collegiate career that she has gained the WCHA weekly honor.
