THIS WEEK'S SERIES: After an idle weekend on Nov. 30-Dec. 2, the St. Cloud State University women's hockey team (8-5-3, 5-5-2 WCHA) heads to Bemidji, Minn., on Saturday and Sunday, Dec. 8-9, for a two-game WCHA series against Bemidji State University (1-12-3, 0-10-2 WCHA). Both games are slated for 2:07 p.m. in the John Glas Fieldhouse.

THE SERIES RECORD: The all-time series between St. Cloud State and Bemidji State is tied, 16-16-5, dating back to the 1998-99 season.

THE LAST TIME OUT: SCSU and BSU skated to a 2-2 overtime tie in the last meeting between the two schools on Jan. 27, 2007, in the National Hockey Center. SCSU's Laura Fast and Meaghan Pezon had goals in the come-from-behind tie.



2007-08 RECORD: The Huskies are 8-5-3 overall and 5-5-2 in the WCHA.

IN THE NHC: The Huskies have posted a 65-86-11 overall home record since 1998.

ON THE ROAD: SCSU has an all-time road record of 44-94-13 since 1998, and a neutral record of 1-4-0.

VOTES IN THE POLLS: St. Cloud State women's hockey received six votes in the USCHO.com Division I Poll released on Nov. 26 and they received four votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Poll released on Nov. 27. The last time the Huskies made the polls was on Nov. 19, 2007, when SCSU received five votes in the USCHO.com Poll.

NUMEROUS GAMES HEARD LIVE ON KVSC: Numerous St. Cloud State women's hockey games will be heard live on KVSC 88.1 FM this season, as well as streamed live at www.kvsc.org. The next scheduled women's hockey game to be heard and streamed live will be on Friday and Saturday, Jan. 4-5, 2008, against Bemidji State in the National Hockey Center.

NELSON ON A RUN: SCSU's Felicia Nelson led the Huskies to a weekend split with Ohio State on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 23-24, with two goals and an assist. The sophomore had six shots against the Buckeyes and now is tied for second on the SCSU squad with 13 points (8g, 5a) in 2007-08. Of note, the St. Paul native has scored in the last four-of-five games, averaging 1.4 points per game (3g, 4a) during that stretch.



Giesen

SCSU'S HEAD COACH JEFF GIESEN: Jeff "Goose" Giesen is in his second season as the head coach of the SCSU women's hockey program in 2007-08. A native of Blaine, Minn., Giesen is the third head coach since the inception of the women's program in 1998. Giesen served as the SCSU assistant women's hockey coach from 2003-2006, working with the Huskies defensive players and recruiting. He came to SCSU from Saint John's University, where he was an assistant coach from 1992-98 and an associate head coach from 1998-2003. Giesen tallied his first career victory against Robert Morris on September 29, 2006, with a 4-0 shutout in the NHC. Giesen's career coaching record stands at 20-23-10 and he has an all-time mark of 12-21-7 in the WCHA. A 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State University and a true student of the game, Coach Giesen and his wife Karla reside in St. Cloud, Minn., with their daughter Delaney.

Johnson

JASON JOHNSON: Jason Johnson joins the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007-08 after serving as an assistant men's hockey coach at nearby Saint John's University since 2003 under the helm of head coach John Harrington, a former SCSU men's assistant coach and Olympic Gold Medalist. During Johnson's coaching years at SJU, the Johnnies won back-to-back Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference

(MIAC) titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. No stranger to the game of hockey, Johnson played four years at Saint John's and tallied 59 points (27g, 32a) in 95 career games played for the Johnnies. His senior season, SJU finished third at the 1997 Division III National Tournament. Johnson's responsibilities at St. Cloud State include recruiting, video breakdown and working with the defensemen. For the past nine years, Johnson has been a first grade teacher at the Albertville Primary School. A resident of St. Michael and 2003 graduate of Hamline University with a master's of arts in education, Johnson and his wife Rachel have two sons, JP and Jack.

JENNIFER KRANZ: Jennifer Kranz, a native of Waukesha, Wis., begins her second season on the SCSU women's hockey staff in 2007. Prior to joining the Husky staff in 2006, Kranz served as the assistant girls' prep ice hockey coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's School in Faribault, Minn., since 2004. At SCSU, Kranz's responsibilities include recruiting, working with the forwards and monitoring team academics. No

stranger to the game, Kranz was a member of the Providence College women's varsity ice hockey team from 1998-2002. She tallied 22 points (12g, 10a) in 104 career games played with the Friars. After graduating from Providence College with a bachelor's of arts in English in 2002, Kranz joined the Shattuck-St. Mary's School as the assistant coach for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. In 2003, Kranz was promoted to the head coach position for the girls' junior prep ice hockey team. Kranz served as the Team Leader at the girls' 15/16's USA Player Development Camp in Lake Placid, NY, in 2005 and in Rochester, NY, in 2006. This past summer, Kranz served as a Team Coach for the girls' 15's USA Player Development camp in St. Cloud, Minn. She has also been actively involved with the Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association since 2000 serving as an evaluator.

BEMIDJI STATE UNIVERSITY (December 8-9)

St. Cloud State University women's hockey (8-5-3, 5-5-2 WCHA) heads to Bemidji, Minn., on Saturday and Sunday, Dec. 8-9, for a two-game WCHA series against Bemidji State University (1-12-3, 0-10-2 WCHA) both games are slated for 2:07 p.m. in the John Glas Field-house...the all-time series between St. Cloud State and Bemidji State is tied, 16-16-5, dating back to the 1998-99 season...in the last five meetings, the two schools have gone 2-2-1 against each other, and in the last 10 meetings, the two schools have gone 4-4-2...St. Cloud State recently earned six votes in the USCHO.com poll released on Nov. 26, and four votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll released on Nov. 27...the Huskies have gone 5-1-1 in the last seven outings.



BSU's Head Coach Steve Sertich

BEAVER PLAYERS TO WATCH: First year forward Eva Schwaerzler leads the Bemidji State offensive attack in 2007-08 with two goals and two assists in 16 games played. Both Julie Rising and Erin Cody have tallied three points this season and six BSU Beavers have chipped in two points a piece. BSU's goaltending has been hot this season, as senior goaltender Emily Brookshaw posted a 0-0 overtime tie against the two-time national defending champions Wisconsin Badgers on Nov. 24, 2007, after backstopping the Beavers with 50 saves in the contest. On the season, Brookshaw has a .928 save percentage, a 2.56 goals against average and a team-leading 487 saves in 16 games played.

BSU HEAD COACH STEVE SERTICH: Steve Sertich is in his second season at at Bemidji State University. In his first year with the Beavers, he led them to an 11-20-5 record overall and a 9-15-4 record in the Women's Collegiate Hockey Association. The 11 wins tied the 2005-06 season final total, and were the most for Bemidji State since the 12-win season from 2001-02. The nine conference wins were the second-most in BSU history, one less than the 2005-06 season total of 10.

Sertich comes to Bemidji State University after spending the last 13 years as the head varsity coach at Roseville Area High School. He coached the Roseville boys' team from 1993-2003, leading it to a 156-71-11 record and two Minnesota State tournament appearances. Under Sertich's guidance, Roseville finished third in the 2002 tournament and second in 2003. He led Roseville to Suburban East Conference Championships in 2002 and 2003. Sertich earned four Coach of the Year honors, as he was named Section 3AA boys' Coach of the Year in 1999; Section 2AA Boys' Coach of the Year in both 2002 and 2003; and Class AA Coach of the Year in 2003.

Sertich is a 1974 graduate of Colorado College with a bachelor's degree in elementary education and humanities. He received a master's degree in elementary education from Minnesota State in 1999.

TIED FOR FOURTH: The St. Cloud State Huskies are currently tied with Ohio State for fourth in the WCHA with 12 league points.

"THANKFUL" FOR THE SPLIT: SCSU's women's hockey team tied the school record of a six-game unbeaten streak on Friday, Nov. 23, with a 4-1 win over Ohio State University before having their streak snapped on Saturday, Nov. 24, with a 1-4 loss to the OSU Buckeyes to earn a Western Collegiate Hockey Association series split on the road at the OSU Ice Rink over Thanksgiving weekend.

"TWO" THUMBS UP FOR HOGAN, CURRIER AND NELSON: In the first game of the series against OSU on Nov. 23, SCSU's Caitlin Hogan (Oakdale), Amy Currier (Fargo, N.D.) and Felicia Nelson (St. Paul) led the Huskies with two points each as Hogan tallied two helpers, and Nelson and Currier each had a goal and an assist in the fifth WCHA victory of the season for St. Cloud State. Hogan now has three two-point games on the season while Nelson and Currier notched their second two-point performance of the season in the win.

NEWELL VS. THE BUCKEYES: Senior goaltender Kendall Newell (Phoenix, Ariz.) combined for 55 saves (.917) in 118:12 minutes of ice time against OSU on Thanksgiving weekend. The senior netminder's season record stands at 6-4-2 and her career mark is 18-18-7 between the pipe. Of note, Newell's .926 season save percentage ranks third in the WCHA.

HOGAN THE HELPER: Leading the way in 2007-08 is Husky sophomore forward Caitlin Hogan. Hogan has a team-leading 12 assists and 15 total points in the season, which ranks her tied for 12th in the WCHA overall scoring and tied for fourth in WCHA overall assist scoring category. Her three game-winning goals this season are also a WCHA second-best in 2007-08 and the Oakdale native also has a team-best plus/minus of +7.

"LUCKY" 13: Meaghan Pezon (Eden Prairie) and Felicia Nelson (St. Paul) both have 13 points on the season for the Huskies with eight goals and five assists each, ranking them tied for 16th in WCHA overall scoring and tied for fourth in WCHA overall goal scoring.

TIED AT THE TOP: SCSU's junior forward Sammy Nixon's four power play goals rank her in a four-way tie for first in the WCHA and her two short-handed points (1g, 1a) rank S. Nixon tied for third in the WCHA.

DÉJÀ VU: The Huskies 2007-08 unbeaten streak of six games was reached on Friday, Nov. 23, at OSU. SCSU went 5-0-1 during that stretch before the streak was ended on Saturday, Nov. 24, with a 4-1 loss to OSU. That six-game unbeaten streak tied a school record. The original record was set during the 2000-01 season, when the Huskies went 5-0-1 during that stretch as well.
