REGULAR SEASON FINALE: The St. Cloud State soccer team (9-7-0, 6-5-0 NSIC) will be back at home this weekend at Husky Stadium for the final two regular season games of the 2010 season.

PARENTS AND SENIOR WEEKEND: The Huskies will first take on Augustana College (7-7-2, 6-4-1 NSIC) in a 1 p.m. game Saturday at Husky Stadium. Saturday's game will also be Parents Day. St. Cloud State will then end the regular season with a 1 p.m. home game with Wayne State College, where senior's Gabrielle Najera (Longmont, Colo.), Lindsey Sather (Eden Prairie), Jessica Pafko (Blaine) and Teresa Gazich (Arden Hills) will be honored before the game.

RECAP OF FINAL ROAD TRIP: The Huskies dropped their first game last weekend 2-1 to the University of Mary on the road Saturday, before earning a 1-0 win over Northern State Sunday afternoon in the final regular season road game.

DEFENSIVE ROAD DOMINANCE: Redshirt freshman goalkeeper Molly Bender (Rockton, Ill.) played in 135 minutes over the weekend, allowing no goals with four saves on the weekend. She will finish the season with no goals allowed on the road after recording her fourth shutout of the season in Sunday's win over Northern State. The Husky defense has only given up 13 goals all season, with the school record set last season at 17.

A LITTLE HELP FROM THE OTHER SIDE: The Huskies scored the only goal of the weekend thanks to Northern State's goalkeeper, who let the ball deflect off her after it hit the cross bar.

MULTI-GOAL LOSS: Friday's loss to the University of Mary was just the second loss this season that the Huskies gave up multiple goals in a contest. SCSU also gave up just two multi-goal games during the 2009 regular season.

Opponent Breakdown...

AUGUSTANA: The Vikings are 7-7-2 overall this season and are in fifth place in the NSIC with a 6-4-1 record after a pair of wins over the weekend. The Huskies are 6-4-4 all-time against Augustana since competition between both squads started in 2000. SCSU lost to the Vikings 4-3 in double overtime and tied 0-0 in double overtime last season.

Augie is led by head coach Brandon Barkus, who is finishing his fifth regular season with a pair of road games this weekend. Barkus has led his team to a 45-48-14 record in nearly five seasons with the team.

Offensively, the Vikings have a balanced scoring attack with three players on the team with three goals this season, but are led by senior Kate Shandri who has four goals in nine games played. Shandri has played in just one of the last eight games.

Sophomore Amanda Wagner started in 14 of 16 games this season in net for Augie. She has a 5-7-2 record with two shutouts, while allowing 14 goals for a .92 goals against average. She has made 94 saves this season in 1,363:46 minutes played in 2010.

WAYNE STATE: The Wildcats head into the final week of the regular season with a 7-5-4 overall record while going 3-4-4 in the NSIC. Northern State will travel to St. Paul to play Concordia University, St. Paul Saturday before traveling to St. Cloud.

SCSU is 2-1 against Wayne State since both teams started competing just three seasons ago. The Huskies beat the Wildcats 5-1 on the road last season.

Head coach Molly Grisham is winding down her second season with the Wildcats after posting a 4-15-1 record in her first season in 2009. She has the Wildcats in 10th place in the conference heading into the final weekend.

Senior Megan Dias has been a dominant force offensively in 2010 for Wayne State. She has posted 24 of the team's 85 points, which has included a team high 10 goals to go with four assists. She also leads the team with 51 shots and 31 shots on net.

Senior goaltender Emily Walker is coming off two shutouts and NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors to go to 6-5-4 in net for the Wildcats. She has made all 16 starts in net, making 78 saves, while allowing 22 goals this season. She has four shutouts in 1470:08 minutes played.



Coach Heiberger-McCabe

Becky Heiberger-McCabe comes into her third season with the Huskies after posting a solid 10-5-5 record in 2009. She also led the Huskies to a third place finish in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a 9-2-2 record that led to her being named NSIC Coach of the Year.



The Huskies recorded a school-record nine shutouts in 2009 and earned the first conference tournament win in school history. Heiberger's 2009 squad beat Bemidji State University in a 6-5 shootout in the first round of the NSIC tournament after eneding regulation tied 1-1 to make it into the second round of play where the Huskies' successful season ended in a 2-1 loss to Minnesota Duluth.

It was only the second time in school history the Huskies have recorded a double-digit win season, and it's the most wins since going 13-5-2 in 1995. In her first season at SCSU, Heiberger led the Huskies to a solid 8-8-2 record, and a 6-5-2 record in the highly competitive Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. SCSU also qualified for play in the 2008 NSIC tournament, thanks to its seventh place overall finish in the league. SCSU's eight wins were the most since 2004, and it marked the team's best win total in team history.
