NCC Play Starts Back Up, Games vs UND, USD, and UNO This Week

TUESDAY'S MEETING WITH UND MOVED TO WEDNESDAY: The doubleheader between St. Cloud State and North Dakota, scheduled for Tuesday evening in Grand Forks, ND, has been moved to Wednesday. The game times will remain the same, with the first game starting up at 3:00 pm.

NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE PLAY IN FULL SWING: After a week-long hiatus from NCC games, the Huskies (23-19, 3-1 NCC) will return to the diamond for league play. They will get three opportunities to take on NCC opponents this week, starting with a doubleheader at North Dakota (8-11, 0-4 NCC) on Wednesday. The Huskies defeated UND in a non-conference game played last weekend by a score of 4-3, pushing the series record to 62-12. SCSU will then return home for a set of games against South Dakota on Friday. The Huskies have not yet seen USD, who has gone 14-21 overall and 2-2 in the NCC. SCSU maintains a 32-11 lead in the series with the Coyotes. Finally, the Huskies will meet up with #11 Nebraska-Omaha (29-6, 5-1 NCC) for a doubleheader at Selke Field on Saturday. SCSU got a look at the NCC favorite last Friday at the CSP Tourney, when the Mavericks took a non-conference 7-2 win over the Huskies. The win lengthens UNO's slight overall series lead to 29-24.

SCSU FINISHES 4-1 AT CSP INVITE: The Huskies improved their overall record to 23-19 with four big wins at the Concordia-St. Paul Invitational last Friday and Saturday. SCSU had a good week-end showing, defeating two of three NCC teams and both NSIC teams played. The Huskies went 2-1 in the first day of action, defeating Invite host CSP 1-0 and NCC-affiliate North Dakota 4-3 before falling to #11 ranked Nebraska-Omaha by a score of 7-1. The Huskies scored a lone fourth inning run against Concordia-St. Paul when Rachel Haines laced down a sacrifice bunt that allowed a waiting Abby Augdahl to score. Trossbach (11-9) pitched the shutout, allowing just four baserunners and two hits.

SCSU went up 3-0 against UND with runs in the fourth and fifth innings. They posted another unearned run in the top of the seventh to take a 4-0 lead in what would turn out to be a much closer game than anticipated. UND made a comeback on their last three outs to get within one run, but were unable to knock in their final runner to tie the game, giving SCSU the 4-3 win. Meggon Staton and Amanda Chancellor scored the RBIs for the Huskies while Trossbach got the win.

The Huskies hung tough with nationally ranked UNO early on, matching a first inning run to tie the game at 1-1. The game remained in a stalemate until the fourth inning when the Mavericks posted four unearned runs to take the game away. The Huskies were unable to recover and fell 7-1. Four SCSU batters had hits while Homan picked up the lone RBI.

In games played on Saturday, SCSU picked up wins against both UMD and MSU, Moorhead to finish 4-1 overall. The Huskies managed one less hit than Minnesota Duluth, putting good balls into play seven times to UMD's eight, but took advantage of Bulldog errors to score two runs and gain a 2-1 win Saturday afternoon. Abby Augdahl got on base in the third inning with a single to left field, advanced on a Bulldog fielding error, and scored on a wild pitch. Christina Borchardt got on base in the fourth inning as a result of an error and was later knocked in with a Jenny Gensch single. Lacey Trossbach gave up just one run in the third inning and had three strikeouts.

A third inning Preiner homerun and a Staton single in the fourth that scored three runners highlighted SCSU's 7-2 win over Minnesota State, Moorhead in the last game of the CSP Invite. The Huskies came up with 10 hits and led the entire game, giving up one run in each of the third and sixth innings. Stef Schroeder completed the game from the mound, striking out three and giving up seven hits.

The Huskies' mark of 4-1 placed them in a three-way tie for best record at the Invite, although Missouri Western took the top position after allowing the fewest earned runs.

TROSSBACH RECEIVES WEEKLY NCC HONORS: SCSU's junior pitcher Lacey Trossbach (St. Inigoes, Md.) was named the North Central Conference Softball Pitcher of the Week for her efforts this past weekend in the Concordia-St. Paul Invitational. Trossbach gave up just one earned run in 19 innings pitched and tallied three wins to her season record in the Invitational. The Huskies went 4-1 on the weekend with their only loss coming to NCC rival Nebraska-Omaha.
