Huskies wrap-up final week of the regular season with 11 games.

**FLURRY OF DIAMOND GAMES IN FINAL WEEK OF SEASON:** St. Cloud State brings a 25-21 overall record and a mark of 5-3 in the NCC into the final week of regular season play. It will be a busy one, with 11 games packed into just five days. The Huskies will start the week off with home field doubleheaders against MSU, Moorhead on Tuesday (3:00/5:00) and Minnesota Duluth (24-15, 2-6 NCC) on Wednesday (2:00/4:00). They will then head to Grand Forks on Thursday for a makeup game with North Dakota (13-21, 0-8 NCC). After a day of rest, the Huskies will play their final regular season games in the MSU/Microtel Inn & Suites Classic on Saturday and Sunday. They will face Washburn, Winona State, and Emporia State on Saturday with game times of 9:00, 11:00, and 3:00, respectively. Next will be Upper Iowa at 10:00 am Sunday morning, followed by a 2:00 date with Southwest Minnesota State.

**HUSKIES SWEEP AND ARE SWEEP:** SCSU took both games of the NCC bout with South Dakota (15-30, 2-10 NCC) Friday afternoon at Selke Field, only to turn around on Saturday and be swept by No. 11 Nebraska-Omaha (41-9, 11-1 NCC).

Lacey Trossbach allowed just two hits and struck out six batters on her way to a fifth shutout in SCSU's Game 1 2-0 win over USD. The early soggy weather may have helped the Huskies, as the Coyotes fumbled with several balls, leading to five errors and SCSU's two unearned runs. Rachel Haines scored both runs for SCSU, knocked in by Ashley Homan and Jessica Preiner. With the weather clearing for Game 2, the Huskies earned eight of their own ten runs and allowed USD to cross the plate just two times, resulting in a 10-2 win. Five Husky players had two hits each, highlighted by a six run, five hit third inning that put the team up 7-0. The Huskies sealed the deal with a fifth inning walk-off homerun by Jessica Preiner that ended the game as a result of the "mercy rule". Stef Schroeder pitched five solid innings, earning her 11th win of the year.

SCSU struggled through the doubleheader with Nebraska-Omaha Saturday afternoon, allowing 12 runs while being shutout in both games. The "mercy rule", which ends the game after five innings if there is at least an eight run differential, was enacted once again in Game 1 with the Mavericks, but this time the Huskies were on the losing end. SCSU fell 0-8 after managing just two hits and failing to score. The Huskies dug themselves in a hole early on, going three and out in the first three innings and, defensively, giving up three runs to UNO in each of the first and second innings. On the pitching front, Trossbach struck out four times as many batters as UNO's Kuster (8 vs 2), but balls that were put into play by the Mavericks resulted in hits far more than swings by the Huskies.

SCSU came out to a much better start in Game 2, holding UNO without a run until the fifth inning. Offensively, however, the Huskies missed opportunities to gain an edge. They left two runners stranded in the first inning and came up with just two more hits the remainder of the game. The Mavericks, on the other hand, hit well off of SCSU's Stef Schroeder, who had five strikeouts but gave up four runs. UNO came alive late in the game, scoring three runs off of a heavy hit by Jorgensen in the sixth inning to go up by a final score of 4-0. Of note, Husky senior Jessica Preiner came up with one of SCSU's two hits, marking her sixth consecutive game with a hit.

**HUSKIES IN THE NCC:** Currently in third place in the regular season NCC standings, the Huskies rank fifth at the plate with a .262 batting average. Their 2.50 pitching ERA is good for third, behind UNO and AC. Individually, SCSU's Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, AK) comes in seventh with a batting average of .356. She ranks second for runs scored (35), third for total bases (88), third for stolen bases (12-12), and fifth for hits (52). First-year player Rachel Haines (Pepin, WI) leads the league in stolen bases, advancing on 18-of-21 attempts. After sending 140 batters back to the dugout, junior Lacey Trossbach (Saint Inigoes, MD) has the third-most strikeouts among any NCC pitcher.
