Huskies Take 3rd In NCC Race, Prepare For League Tourney This Weekend

**FLURRY OF DIAMOND GAMES IN FINAL WEEK OF SEASON:** With a third place finish in the regular NCC standings, the Huskies (30-22, 8-4 NCC) will face #6 South Dakota (17-30, 2-10 NCC) in the first round of the NCC tournament. The annual playoff tournament will be held this Friday and Saturday (May 5-6) at Ulland Park in Grand Forks, ND. SCSU's first game will start at 10 a.m. on Field 2, with resulting games to follow throughout the day and weekend. **SCSU GOES 5-1 IN FINAL GAMES OF REGULAR SEASON:** Although they expected to play far more games in the final week of the 2006 regular season, the Huskies finished the schedule out strong, winning all games played at home against MSU, Moorhead and Minnesota Duluth and splitting games with North Dakota on the road. SCSU was slated to play five games at the MSU/Microtel Inn & Suites Classic last weekend, but the event was cancelled due to poor weather conditions.

The Huskies swept MSU, Moorhead Tuesday afternoon, winning 2-0 and 7-1. Both of SCSU's Game 1 runs came in the third inning, when a balanced offensive effort scored Gensch and Augdahl, with rbi's going to Preiner and Homan. The squad punched out 12 hits in Game 2, scoring seven runs, including a four-run third inning. Augdahl led SCSU with three hits, three runs, and two rbi's in four at-bats.

The Huskies went on to sweep the UMD Bulldogs Wednesday afternoon, winning 8-4 and 3-1. Appropriately on a day that honored SCSU seniors, Preiner and Augdahl combined for five hits, four runs, and four rbi's in Game 1. SCSU took an early and comfortable 4-0 lead, although the Bulldogs managed to tie the game up with one swing, a fourth inning grand slam by UMD's Colby. The effort was muted, however, as the Huskies went on to knock in four more runs while defending the field to prevent any further Bulldog runs and gain the win. Game 2 was won in another great SCSU third inning when, with the bases loaded, Homan doubled to the right center fence, scoring all three runners to put SCSU up 3-0. UMD was able to score one run in the top of the sixth, but were unable to close the gap.

In their final NCC games of the season, the Huskies dropped a 6-5 decision in Game 1 of the doubleheader with North Dakota, but rallied back to take Game 2 by a score of 6-2. The teams battled back and forth in Game 1, the Huskies trying to pull off a sweep to claim second place in the NCC, while UND was simply trying to get more than one NCC win. In the end, a strong batting effort by UND put the home team on top by a single run in the bottom of the seventh inning. The determined Huskies came back and wrapped up their regular season with a confidence-building 6-2 win. Homan knocked out a two-run homer in the first inning, O. Graham slammed a hit over the fence with the first pitch of the second inning, and Augdahl punched out the team's second two-run homer in the fifth inning, enough firepower to put SCSU over the top and knock out UND.

Pitcher Stef Schroeder went 3-1 in play last week, striking out 23 batters in 19.2 innings. Trossbach pitched 22.0 innings and posted a mark of 2-0 with 16 strikeouts. Both pitchers gave up seven runs and walked four batters.

**HUSKIES IN THE NCC:** With a third place finish in the regular season NCC standings, the Huskies rank fifth at the plate with a .272 batting average. Their 2.48 pitching ERA is good for third, behind UNO and AC.

Individually, SCSU's Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, AK) comes in third with a batting average of .380. She ranks second for runs scored (.88/g), second for hits (1.19/g), second for total bases (3.02/g), and fourth for home runs (9, .17/g). The Huskies take four of the top five positions for stolen bases, with Rachel Haines leading the league with 21 steals this season. Augdahl ranks third (15 sb), Gensch ranks fourth (13 sb), and Preiner ranks fifth (11 sb). Designated hitter Ashley Homan is tied for third in the NCC for RBIs, knocking in .71 runs per game.

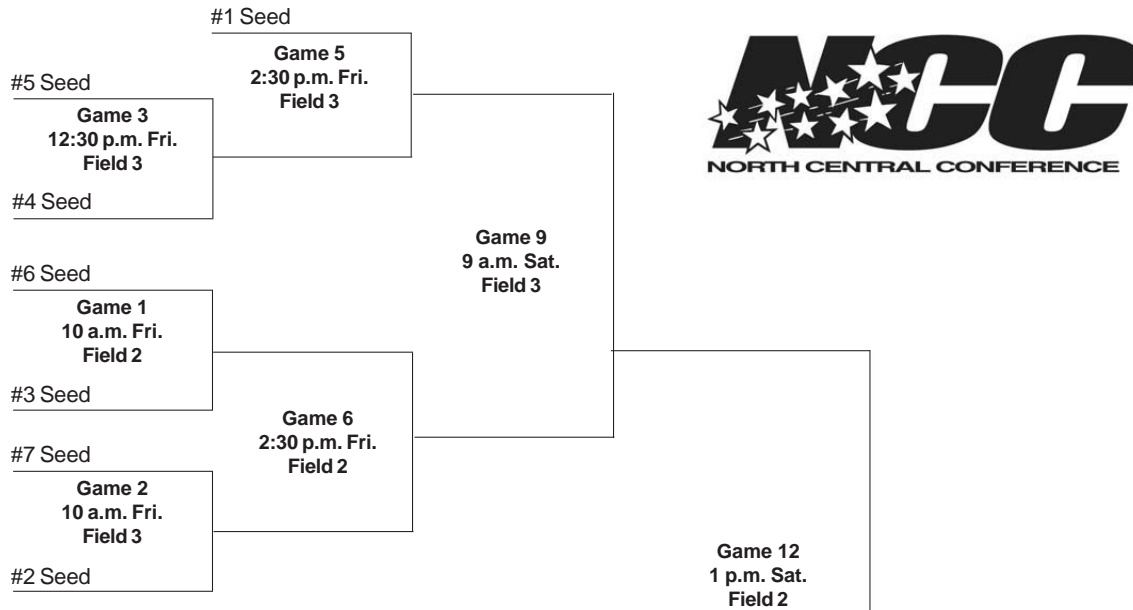
