SCSU 16-15 overall, Open NCC Play On The Road



HUSKIES OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY ON THE ROAD: North Central Conference play begins this week, with the Huskies traveling to Minnesota State (17-12) on Friday and Augustana College (8-11) on Saturday. Both meetings with NCC opponents will be doubleheaders. Friday's games at MSU will start at 1:00 and 3:00 pm and Saturday's games at AC will start at 12:00 and 2:00 pm.

THE SERIES: The Huskies have losing records against both Minnesota State and Augustana College. They are 49-53 against the Mavericks, including a non-conference 8-10 loss earlier this season. The Vikings maintain a 26-50 lead in the series against SCSU, although the Huskies have gone 5-2 against AC in the past three years.

ROAD MATCHUP WITH CSP POSTPONED, HOME SERIES WITH UIU CANCELLED: Two Husky doubleheaders scheduled for last week were not played, due to inclement weather. Thursday's trip to Concordia-St. Paul will be rescheduled for a later date, to be determined. The home games against Upper Iowa, scheduled for Sunday, were cancelled.

SCSU BATS HEAT UP ON COLD FIELDS: Playing in their first outdoor games in the midwest this season, the Huskies totalled 38 hits in doubleheaders against South Dakota State and Winona State this week. While their offense remained tight, their defense was touch and go, resulting in a 2-2 record on the week. They split games with both SDSU and WSU to bring their season record to 16-14.

SCSU's junior firstbaseman Meggan Staton and senior centerfielder Abby Augdahl led the Husky's offense attack in the first game against SDSU with two hits apiece. SDSU jumped out with a 2-0 lead after the bottom of the first inning and never looked back. SCSU's junior pitcher Lacey Trossbach suffered the loss on the mound, as her season record stands at 8-6. Trossbach tallied nine strikeouts in six innings pitched.

The Huskies redeemed themselves with an 8-2 win over SDSU in the second game of the doubleheader. Senior Abby Augdahl exploded for five hits and four runs scored to lead SCSU to their 15th win of the 2006 season. Senior firstbaseman Jessica Preiner found the hot bat herself as she contributed four hits in the Husky offensive attack, including three RBIs. Stef Schroeder, SCSU's sophomore pitcher, earned her seventh win of the season on the mound after pitching a complete seven inning game. Schroeder notched seven strikeouts in the Husky victory. SCSU opened the season's first homestand at Selke Field on Saturday against Winona State, taking the first game 2-0 but dropping a heartwrenching second game 8-11 in extra innings. SCSU's two runs in the first game both came in the third inning, when Preiner singled to score Gensch and Staton popped a sac fly to drive in Augdahl. With a 2-0 lead, the Huskies kicked their defense into high gear and closed the game after Winona State left a total of 11 runners stranded. Lacey Trossbach pitched for her ninth win of the season, striking out four batters in her third shutout.

The Huskies entered the fifth inning of the second game with an 8-3 lead after two big hits earlier in the game scored six runs for the home team. Winona responded late in the game, however, and knocked out two homeruns to tie the game in the seventh inning. The Huskies were held without a hit in the final five innings of the game and suffered a disappointing 8-11 loss. Trossbach took the loss at the mound, pitching the final 2.1 innings.

AUGDAHL RECEIVES PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR: Senior outfielder Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, Alaska) was named co-NCC Player of the Week for her efforts against South Dakota State and Winona State last week. Augdahl batted .571 (8x14) with two doubles, one homerun and one walk while knocking in four RBIs and scoring five runs. Augdahl currently leads the Huskies with a .394 batting average on the season and is second in the NCC for hits with 39. She will share the honor with South Dakota's Sarah Wrage.
