Huskies Finish 2006 Season 33-24 Overall, 8-4 In NCC For Third Place

2006 FINAL RECORD: The 2006 version of St. Cloud State softball went 33-24 overall and posted a mark of 8-4 in North Central Conference play. The biggest win for the squad came on March 25, 2006, when they pulled off a 3-2 upset over #1 Emporia State.



NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS: Grand Forks, ND - As they did in the regular NCC season, the St. Cloud State Huskies finished third in the race for a North Central Conference title. In the double-elimination style tournament format, the Huskies gained wins against South Dakota 5-3, Minnesota Duluth 10-9, and North Dakota 3-1 but lost to eventual champion Augustana 3-0 and nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha 4-1. #2 seeded Augustana (29-19) knocked off top-seeded Nebraska-Omaha (45-11) twice on the weekend to claim the 2006 title. Both teams advanced to the NCAA tournament.

TRIO OF HUSKIES ON ALL-NCC ROSTER: St. Cloud State had three players named to the All-North Central Conference, a 13-player roster voted on by the league's coaches. Seniors Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, AK) and Jess Preiner (Stillwater, MN) were named to the list for the first time in their careers, while sophomore Ashley Homan (Cottage Grove, MN) received her second career nomination. SCSU center fielder Augdahl led the Huskies with a .363 batting average, totalling 66 hits, including a team-high nine homeruns. Preiner, SCSU's presence behind the plate, batted .353 with 60 hits, including seven homeruns. She led the squad with 302 putouts. Homan came through as the designated hitter for SCSU this season, batting .314 with 50 hits and a team high 41 RBIs.

AUGDAHL RECEIVES SECOND CAREER ACADEMIC ALL-NCC BID: Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, Alaska), a senior member of the St. Cloud State softball team, was named to the 2006 Academic All-North Central Conference team. Augdahl is one of five repeat selections to the 12-player team, as voted on by the league's sports information directors. The Elementary Education major currently led the Huskies with a .363 batting average after totalling 66 hits, 48 runs, and 32 RBIs, all while maintaining a gpa of 3.72. Augdahl was a perfect baserunner this season as well, successfully stealing bases on 16-of-16 attempts.

Player Profiles:



5 Danielle Stump (First-Year) Stump saw playing time in 34 games this season...batted .161 with five hits and nine runs, but was used mainly as a pinch runner...was 6-of-7 for stolen bases.

6 Christina Borchardt (Sophomore) was SCSU's primarily left fielder, playing in all 57 games...batted .218 with 32 hits and had 60 putouts...posted a .970 fielding percentage.



7 Abby Augdahl (Senior) led the team in hits (66, 3rd NCC), runs (48, 2nd NCC), homeruns (9, 5th NCC), and total bases (109, 2nd NCC)...her.363 batting average topped the SCSU list and was fourth highest in the league...was named NCC Player of the Week on April 4...named All-NCC and Academic All-NCC.



8 Jillian Graham (Junior) played in 44 games, making 12 starts...batted .147 with five hits and nine runs...stole eight bases.



9 Laura Melde (First-Year) played in 21 games...scored five runs in 18 at bats...had three putouts on the season.



10 Olivia Graham (Sophomore) played and started in 56 games in 2006...came on strong toward the end of the season, finishing with a .229 batting average...tied the team high for homeruns in a game with two homers against South Dakota on May 5...drove in 24 RBIs, good for fourth on the team...put out 119 players.



13 Stef Schroeder (Sophomore) in just her sophomore campaign, Schroeder pitched in 32 games for the Huskies and posted a 14-14 record...among NCC pitchers, Schroeder walked the third-lowest number of batters (31)...struck out 150 batters and gave up 64 earned run for a 3.12 ERA.



14 Rachel Haines (First-Year) took over as SCSU's primary second baseman, playing and starting in all 57 games...batted .243 with 44 hits and 24 runs...led the NCC with 23 stolen bases in 26 attempts...had 126 putouts on the season.

18 Ashley Homan (Sophomore) served as SCSU's designated hitter and posted the team's third-highest batting average of .314...led the Huskies and came in fourth in the NCC with 41 RBIs...also posted 50 hits, 14 runs, and 25 walks.

17 Lacey Trossbach (Junior) made 32 starts from the rubber in 2006 and finished the season with a 19-10 record...led SCSU's pitchers with a 3.00 ERA...pitched five shutouts...struck out 172 batters in 207.1 innings pitched, fourth most among league pitchers.



16 Meggan Staton (Junior) was limited in playing time due to injury and wrapped up her collegiate career after playing in 29 games...batted .274 with 17 hits in 62 at-bats...had 97 putouts from the first base position.

20 Kelsey Thompson (First-Year) played in 49 games in 2006 and made 41 starts...shared time in the infield at both first and third bases...was second on the team in putouts with 223...batted .238 with 29 hits in 122 at-bats.



21 Jessica Preiner (Senior) finished her playing career as one of SCSU's best players...was second on the team with a .353 batting average, posting 60 hits, 36 runs, and 30 RBIs...played in and started all 57 games this season...made starts in the last 167 consecutive games of her career...led the team with 302 putouts...stole 11 bases.

22 Jenny Gensch (Sophomore) started at the third base position for all 57 games this season...batted .273 with 39 hits, including eight doubles...stole 13 bases and had 104 putouts.



24 Amanda Chancellor (First-Year) played in 37 games in her rookie campaign as a right fielder...batted .238 with 19 hits on the year...hit her first career home-run on March 18, 2006 against the University of Mary.

25 Kelly Durkin (First-Year) played in nine games in her first year at SCSU...made one start.



SCSU HEAD COACH PAULA U'REN

9 SEASONS OF EXCELLENCE AT SCSU

The 2006 season was the ninth year that Paula U'Ren served as head coach for the St. Cloud State softball team. She takes with her perhaps the most successful program at St. Cloud State -- in U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament 6 times and have won the North Central Conference play-off championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

U'Ren's maintains a 363-146 career record at SCSU for a winning percentage of 71.3%. U'Ren brought home SCSU's first NCC championship title in 1998, her first year as a head coach. SCSU has since gained NCAA bids in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, and 2004.

U'Ren is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-America selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
