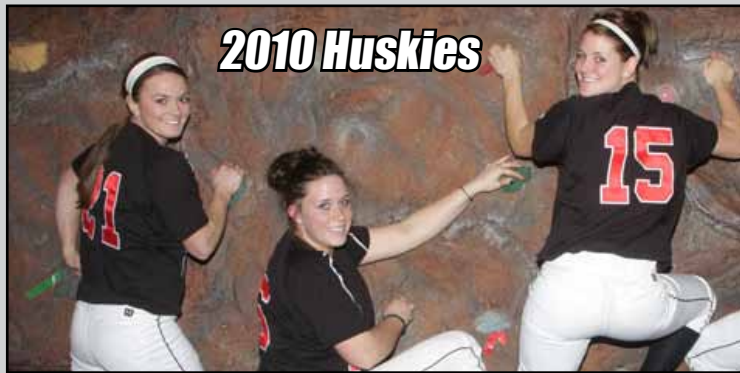


Husky Media - Directions to Historic Selke Field

Directions to Selke Field

From Interstate 94: Exit County Rd. 75 (St. Augusta Exit). Travel north on 75 to Clearwater Road. Turn right onto Clearwater to 16th Street. Turn right on 16th Street. Follow street around curve and proceed north about 2 blocks. At University Ave. (stop light), take a right and cross over bridge. Go through the first set of lights, Selke Field is two blocks on your left. Parking is available on the street east of Selke Field.

From Highway 10: Exit on 15th Avenue Southeast. Proceed south to University Avenue. Turn right. Proceed west to 12th Avenue Southeast. Turn right. Selke Field is located on your left, and parking is available on both sides of the street.

Press Credentials

Admission to Husky Stadium press box, the Halenbeck Hall press box and the Selke Field press box is restricted to the working press. Requests for working press passes and permission to broadcast games must be made at least one week in advance to the SCSU Athletic Media Relations Director. Only media representatives actually involved in the coverage of the game will be admitted into the press box.

Photo Passes

Photo passes must also be requested one week in advance. Photographers may operate along the sidelines and must adhere to the restricting lines around the field and court.

Press Services

A complete NCAA box score will be made available to all media following the completion of the game. Complete individual and team statistics, including play-by-play and half-time summary will be provided for all working media. Statistics are available in the press box. Contact the Athletics Media Relations representative for post-game interviews with players and coaches.

Press Phones

Phones will be available for media use following each home game.

Radio/Phone Lines/Internet Access

Radio space will be reserved for the official play-by-play stations designated by each visiting school. Other radio stations will be given space on a first-come, first-serve basis and on availability. Information concerning phone lines may be obtained by calling the AMR office at 320-308-2141. Two ethernet lines are available in the AMR office, along with wireless access - both require access codes, so please call in advance if you need. Phones will be available in the AMR office for media use following each home game.
