2009 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

HOME SWEET DOME: St. Cloud State returns home for three days of action in the Husky Dome on Feb. 27-Mar. 1. The Huskies will play a non-conference doubleheader against Northern State on Feb. 27, and then play host to the fifth annual Husky Dome Invitational on Feb. 28-Mar. 1 in the Husky Dome.

NORTHERN STATE BRIEFLY: This Huskies are 11-1 all-time against Northern State University, dating back to the 1980 season. Last year, St. Cloud State tabbed a 3-0 mark against the Wolves.

MINNESOTA STATE BRIEFLY: St. Cloud State trails the all-time series with Minnesota State, 51-58, dating back to 1976. Last season, the Mavericks won all three games over the Huskies in the last season of the North Central Conference.

BEMIDJI STATE BRIEFLY: The Huskies lead the all-time series over Bemidji State 46-4, dating back to 1969. In 2008, SCSU went 3-1 overall against the Beavers, including a 15-0 five-inning shutout victory on Apr. 22, 2008.

SOUTHWEST MN STATE BRIEFLY: Southwest Minnesota State and St. Cloud State split last year on Apr. 9, as SMSU took the first game 1-0 and the Huskies retaliated with a 4-3 victory. SCSU holds the advantage in the all-time series, 47-31, dating back to 1973.

NSIC/RMAC CROSSOVER RESULTS: St. Cloud State participated in the 2009 NSIC/RMAC Crossover Tournament hosted by the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs on Feb. 20-22. The Huskies went 1-5 overall at the Crossover, garnering its lone win of the weekend over RMAC preseason favorite Mesa State in a thrilling come-from-behind 6-5 victory in the bottom of the seventh inning.

UCCS RESULTS: The Huskies earned a non-conference split against the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs on Thursday, Feb. 19, winning the first game 11-3 and dropping the second stint 2-7. Junior pitcher Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) went the distance for the Huskies against UCCS in the first game of the twin bill, posting her first win of the season after striking out six UCCS batters in 7.0 innings pitched.

HIT AWAY HAINES: Senior co-captain Rachel Haines had a stellar outing in Colorado this past week. In eight games played, the Pepin, Wis., native charted 15 hits, five RBI's, seven runs scored and a team-best .500 batting average at the plate. On the season, Haines leads all Husky players with a .429 batting average, 21 hits and 11 runs scored.

WIN FOR KRIEG: Rookie pitcher Brit Krieg (1-4) garnered her first career victory in the circle on Feb. 22 against Mesa State, pitching a complete game and striking out one Mesa State batter in the process.

400 CLUB: The Huskies have three individuals batting .400 or better in this young season. Rachel Haines leads with a .429 batting average, while sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Kelly Laas (Frankfort, Ill.) are second on the squad with a .419 batting average and a .400 batting average respectively.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

U'Ren

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren brings an impressive 426-197 overall career mark into her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
