HUSKIES PREPARE FOR REBEL SPRING GAMES: St. Cloud State University's softball team (6-4, 0-0 NCC) will head to the sunshine state of Florida on March 4-10 for the Rebel Spring Games in Osceola, Florida.

2007 SEASON RECORD: The Huskies are 6-4 overall in 2007 and 0-0 in the North Central Conference.

REBEL SPRING GAME OPPONENTS: Coach Paula U'Ren's Husky squad will play a dozen games while they are down in Florida for the Rebel Spring Games coming up in early March. On March 4, the Huskies will face Southern Indiana and Northern Kentucky. Day two (March 5), SCSU will face Findlay and Kentucky Wesleyan, and on Day three (March 6), the Huskies will suit up against Georgian Court and Dowling. SCSU will take the day off on March 7 to do some sight-seeing, and return to action on March 8 for games against Southern Indiana and SIU-Edwardsville. Coach U'Ren's squad will complete the Rebel Spring Games on March 9 and 10, with games against Bellarmine, Northern Kentucky, Shippensburg and Findlay.

HUSKY DOME INVITATIONAL RESULTS: SCSU's softball team hosted the third annual Husky Dome Invitational on Feb. 24-25 and posted an 0-3 record in the Invite. In the first day of competition, SCSU suffered a 3-0 loss to Minnesota State, Moorhead and a 4-0 loss to Southwest Minnesota State University. Sunday morning, the Huskies forced UW-Parkside into extra innings, and eventually charted a 13-7 loss in nine innings. Teams participating in the Invite were UW-Parkside, Minnesota Duluth, Southwest Minnesota State, Minnesota State Moorhead and St. Cloud State. Minnesota State, Mankato was originally scheduled to play in the Invite, yet due to weather, had to drop out.

SCSU GAINS TWO WINS OVER JAMESTOWN COLLEGE: The Huskies tallied a non-conference doubleheader sweep against Jamestown College on Friday, Feb. 23, with 6-4 and 4-1 victories. SCSU tallied 17 combined hits with a .315 batting average in the two games. SCSU now leads the all-time series over JC, 4-0, dating back to 1993.

GRAHAM LEADING OFFENSIVELY: St. Cloud State's junior catcher Olivia Graham (Falcon Heights) is currently leading the Huskies with 12 hits, two home runs, a .387 batting average and 21 total bases in 2007. Jenny Gensch, a junior and native of Apple Valley, is leading SCSU with eight runs batted in and nine runs scored. Sophomore Kelsey Thompson is the team leader with three doubles in 2007. On the mound, junior Stef Schroeder leads with three wins and a 2.64 ERA.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren enters her tenth season as head coach at St. Cloud State in 2006-07. She takes with her perhaps the most successful program at SCSU. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles). U'Ren's 363-146 career record at SCSU ranks 14th among active NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .713.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the

NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall).

In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren.

A native of Mapleton, Minn., U'Ren owns an impressive 363-146 record as a collegiate coach. She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-America selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

2006 St. Cloud State Softball Season Recap

2006 SEASON RECAP: SCSU (33-24, 8-4 NCC/3rd) completed its 2006 season with a third place finish in the NCC Tournament. After tallying a regular season third place finish in the NCC, SCSU recorded wins against South Dakota (5-3), Minnesota Duluth (10-9) and North Dakota (3-1), before dropping games to the eventual tournament champion Augustana (0-3) and nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha (1-4) in the double-elimination NCC Tournament. SCSU's head coach Paula U'Ren continued the season win streak of 30 games and has now managed to achieve over 30 wins in each of her nine seasons here at St. Cloud State. This season marked the second straight season since 2001 that the Huskies had not received an NCAA tournament bid, and just the third time in U'Ren's tenure that SCSU has not been invited to the big dance. The NCC tournament runner-up in 2005, the Huskies won the conference title in 1998, 2003 and 2004. A top NCAA Division II softball power, SCSU owns a 363-146 record under head coach U'Ren since 1998. Over that period of time, SCSU has won three conference titles, one regional title and the Huskies placed third in the nation at the NCAA Division II championships in 2004.
