## 2009 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: March 3, 2009



**HUSKIES HEAD TO SUNNY FLORIDA:** The St. Cloud State softball squad will head to sunny Florida for spring break to participate in the 2009 Rebel Spring Games from Mar. 7-11 in Orlando. The Huskies will play 10 games during their stint in Florida.

**THE RECORD:** The Huskies have won their last five of six games and are 6-13 overall and 0-0 in the NSIC.

**ON TAP FOR REBEL SPRING GAMES:** St. Cloud State is slated to face 10 opponents at the Rebel Spring Games during the five days of their stay in Orlando, Fla. On the first day of competition (Mar. 7), SCSU will take the field against Holy Family and Wilmington (DE). The next day the Huskies will face Stonehill and Ashland. The third and fourth days St. Cloud State will compete against Saint Rose, C.W. Post, Palm Beach Atlantic and Ferris State. The Huskies will wrap up the Rebel Spring Games with non-conference action against Quincy and Tiffin.

**ALL-TIME SERIES:** The Huskies will face Holy Family, Wilmington, Saint Rose and Palm Beach Atlantic for the first time in school history at the Rebel Spring Games. SCSU is 2-0 all-time against Stonehill (1997), 3-1 all-time against Ashland (1999), 4-1 all-time versus C.W. Post (2000), 2-2 all-time against Ferris State (1993) and 1-0 all-time against Quincy (2003) and Tiffin (2001).

**HUSKY DOME INVITE RESULTS:** St. Cloud State played host to the fifth annual Husky Dome Invitational on Feb. 28-Mar. 1 in the Husky Dome. The Huskies 1-2 in the Invite, dropping their first game to Minnesota State (3-5), and sweeping the last two against Bemidji State (2-0) and Southwest Minnesota State (6-5).

Participating in the Invite this year was Bemidji State, Minnesota State, Northern State, South Dakota, Southwest Minnesota State, St. Cloud State University and Valley City State (ND).

**KRIEG THROWS NO-HITTER:** St. Cloud State softball team got an exclamation point on the weekend with a no-hitter from first year pitcher Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.) in 4-0 game-two win over Northern State on Friday, Feb. 27, marking the first no-hitter of her young collegiate career. Just two days later, Krieg threw a perfect six innings straight against

Bemidji State on Sunday, Mar. 1, but a leadoff single in the top of the seventh ruined her bid at a perfect game. Still, once on first, the Beaver runner was stranded as Krieg retired the next three batters in order to give the Huskies the 2-0 win. The rookie went 3-1 on the weekend, striking out 13 opponents in 22.2 innings pitched while garnering a 1.85 ERA and her first two career shutouts in the process.

**SWING AWAY STALKER:** Sophomore shortstop Sarah Stalker had an outstanding weekend for the Huskies, leading them to a 4-1 overall mark from Friday, Feb. 27-Mar. 1, in the Husky Dome. The Hudson, Wis., native swung for a team-best .615 average, 8 hits, 3 runs scored, 1 home run and 6 RBI's in five games played. On Sunday (Mar. 1) alone, Stalker hit her team-leading second home run of the season against SMSU, and finished with three hits on the day to lead the Huskies to two wins over NSIC rivals Bemidji State (2-0) and Southwest Minnesota State (6-5).

**THREE CHEERS FOR HUSKIES:** In the last five games played this past weekend, the Huskies as a team batted .371, charting 49 hits in 132 at-bats and posting a .485 slugging percentage.

**STREVER GARNERS SHUTOUT:** Junior pitcher Kaity Strever garnered another win this past weekend against Northern State with a 5-0 shutout, marking the first shutout of the season and fifth of her career. The Laural, Mont., native also tallied seven strikeouts in 12.1 innings pitched since Feb. 27. Strever is now 2-6 this season.

**AT THE HELM IN '09:** The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

**LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009:** For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laural, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

**COACH U'REN'S CORNER:** Paula U'Ren has an impressive 432-210 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
