HUSKY UPDATE FROM SUNNY FLORIDA: St. Cloud State has improved to 10-13 overall after tallying four straight victories at the Rebel Spring Games in Orlando, Fla., from Mar. 7-8. The Huskies will continue action at the Rebel Spring Games until Mar. 11, then return home for a non-conference doubleheader against No. 6-ranked Winona State (13-3, 0-0 NSIC) on Saturday, Mar. 14, in the Husky Dome.

THE RECORD: The Huskies have won their last six games straight games and are 10-13 overall and 0-0 in the NSIC.

REMAINING REBEL SPRING GAMES SCHEDULE: St. Cloud State is slated to face six more opponents at the Rebel Spring Games from Mar. 9-11 in Orlando, Fla. After garnering four straight victories, the Huskies prepare for games against Saint Rose, C.W. Post, Palm Beach Atlantic and Ferris State on the third and fourth days. The Huskies will wrap up the Rebel Spring Games with non-conference action against Quincy and Tiffin.

ALL-TIME SERIES: The Huskies faced Holy Family and Wilmington (Del.) for the first time in school history, and will also meet up against Saint Rose and Palm Beach Atlantic for the first time in school history at the Rebel Spring Games. SCSU is 3-0 all-time against Stonehill (1997), 4-1 all-time against Ashland (1999), 4-1 all-time versus C.W. Post (2000), 2-2 all-time against Ferris State (1993) and 1-0 all-time against Quincy (2003) and Tiffin (2001).

KEEPING THE STREAK ALIVE: The Huskies are on a six-game win streak, dating back to Mar. 1, 2009.

LAAS IS MORE: Kelly Laas has played an important role in SCSU's six-game win streak, leading the Huskies to four straight victories at the Rebel Spring Games in Orlando, Fla., after posting a .533 batting average in the last four games played. In 15 at-bats, the sophomore slugger has a team-leading eight hits, six runs scored and a team second-best five runs batted in to lead St. Cloud State to a 4-0 mark in the sunny state of Florida.

SAVE AWAY: First year Brit Krieg earned her first career save against Wilmington (DE) at the Rebel Spring Games in Orlando, Fla., on Saturday, Mar. 7, and went on to tab a 2-0 record the past two days in the sunny state of Florida, garnering wins over Holy Family (Mar. 7) and Stonehill (Mar. 8). In 13.0 innings pitched, the Hudson (Wis.) native has totaled nine strikeouts with a 1.62 ERA.

FOUR MORE FOR LIZZY: Lizzy Dwyer, SCSU's junior slap hitter, had a career game against Stonehill on Mar. 8, going 4-for-5 at the plate, which ties a career best four hits in a game. On the weekend, Dwyer charted six hits, two runs scored, a triple, a double and a team-best six RBI's for a .400 batting average in four games played.

WELCOME TO THE .500 CLUB: St. Cloud State's rookie Nicole Brandenburg has amassed a .500 batting average in the past four games at the Rebel Spring Games, posting six hits and three runs scored in 12 at-bats, including a team-high three doubles.

TWO TALLIES FOR STREVER - Junior pitcher Kaity Strever tacked two more wins onto her season record this past weekend at the Rebel Spring Games, pitching 14.0 innings against Wilmington (Del.) and Ashland, posting 10 strikeouts in the process. The Laurel, Mont., native is now 4-6 overall in 2009.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

U'Ren

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren has an impressive 436-210 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
