### Huskies Go .500 at the Rebel Spring Games



**HOME SWEET DOME:** SCSU (10-10, 0-0 NCC) returns home to face the University of Mary (Bismarck, N.D.) on Saturday, March 18th, in a double header at the Husky Dome. The first pitch of the double header is set to be thrown at 1:00 p.m. CT.

**HUSKIES SPLIT IN THE SUNSHINE:** Warm weather, dry fields and lots of softball was in store for the St. Cloud State University softball team as they traveled to Kissimmee, Fla., to play in the Rebel Spring Games, March 5-11th.

The Huskies started off their week-long venture dropping a tough first game against Southern Illinois University (Edwardsville), 4-8. Ashley Homan and Rachel Haines both tallied an RBI in the first loss of the games. March 5th was wrapped up with a 2-6 loss to Northern Kentucky University out of Highland Heights. The only two Huskies runs were drove in by Homan when attempting a Husky comeback with a double in the sixth inning. Lacey Trossbach earned only two of the six NKU runs while the rest of the team tallied up four errors.

The second day started much like the first, hard battles but ending in a loss, being edged out by Ferris State University (Big Rapids, Mich.) 3-4 in eight innings. Stef Schroeder took the loss for the Huskies, giving up only six hits and striking out ten. St. Cloud State soon turned their game around turning on the heat and the swings with a 9-3 over the University of Findlay (Findlay, Ohio). Junior Megan Staton (Anoka, Minn.) added insurance runs to the Huskies lead, popping a three-run homerun in the sixth inning.

The second day continued in the evening hours, when SCSU faced off against the University of Southern Indiana (Evansville) and Philadelphia University. Another loss was tallied on SCSU's 1-3 record thus far into the Rebel games, after the Huskies dropped a 0-3 loss to Southern Indiana. They were able to come back with a win under the lights closing the evening with shutout against Philadelphia, 7-0. Trossbach earned the win giving up on two hits in the shutout and struck out eleven batters. The Huskies ended day two 2-3, with many games to come, picking up play on the 9th, after taking the 8th off for the much needed relaxation.

The Huskies split their games on March 9th, the first was a loss against Lewis University (Romeoville, Ill.) 0-4 and the second claimed SCSU the victor over Dowling College, 5-3. The Huskies led 4-0 going into the bottom of the sixth as Dowling made every effort to comeback with one run at the end of the inning. SCSU added an insurance run in the top of the seventh inning when Jessica Preiner knocked in Rachel Haines to equate the final score of 5-3.

St. Cloud continued play on the 10th facing both the University of Indianapolis and Bellarmine University (Louisville, Kentucky). The Huskies dropped their first game of the day to Indianapolis 3-1, and needed to finish their final three games of the Rebel games with three wins to return to Minnesota with a .500 record. Preiner tallied the only run for the Huskies with a solo homerun in the sixth inning.

Schroeder earned her first shutout of the Rebel Games while helping the Huskies to their second with an 8-0 victory over Bellarmine in five innings. Christina Borchardt had two RBI's on three hits and scored one run. Jenny Gensch also had three hits, two runs and an RBI to end the game against Bellarmine.

The Huskies finished their trip to the Sunshine State with two wins on March 11th, charting a 7-0 win over Wisconsin-Parkside (Kenosha, Wisc.) and a 3-1 win over Shippensburg State (Shippensburg, Penn.) in nine innings of play. Schroeder earned her second shutout of the games allowing six hits with ten strikeouts and Lacey Trossbach claimed the win against Shippensburg giving up only one run in the first inning and tallying seven strikeouts. Homan knocked in both Haines and Preiner in the ninth inning on a single to take the victory for the Huskies. The Huskies claimed a .500 record at the Rebel Games in Kissimmee, Fla., owning a 10-10 overall record as they return to Minnesota. SCSU softball had 84 hits on 324 at bats in Florida with a team batting average of .259.
