2009 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

CONFERENCE SEASON BEGINS: St. Cloud State will open Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference competition for the first time in school history on Saturday, Mar. 28, with a twin bill against Minnesota Duluth at historic Selke Field. The first pitch is slated for 12 p.m. The following day, the Huskies will entertain NSIC opponent Bemidji State. That doubleheader is also scheduled for a 12 p.m. start.

BACK UP PLAN: Due to the Minnesota weather and the conditions of Selke Field, St. Cloud State does have the Husky Dome reserved as a back-up facility if the Huskies need to use it for their doubleheaders against Minnesota Duluth on Mar. 28 and Bemidji State on Mar. 29. At the Husky Dome, the UMD games are scheduled to start at 8 p.m. on Saturday night and the BSU games are slated to start at 8:30 p.m. on Sunday evening.

THE RECORD: The Huskies are 13-18 overall heading into NSIC competition.

BIG WIN FOR HUSKIES: St. Cloud State tabbed a huge 5-0 shutout win over then No. 6-ranked Winona State on Saturday, Mar. 14, in the Husky Dome. The Huskies have now won twice this season over a top-25 ranked team and continue to lead the all-time series over WSU, 42-31, dating back to the 1969 season.

STRIKE AWAY STREVER: SCSU's junior pitcher Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) led the Huskies in the big win over No. 6-ranked and NSIC preseason champion Winona State on Mar. 14. Strever pitched fantastic from the circle, improving to 7-8 overall after giving up just four hits to Winona State. From Mar. 9-14, the Laurel, Mont., native made four appearances, going 2-2 overall with a 1.59 ERA and striking out six opponents.

NEW CAREER HIGH FOR UPCHURCH: In the past eight games played, Melanie Upchurch led all Husky players with five runs batted in, including one RBI in the big win over No. 6 Winona State on Mar. 14. Against the Warriors, Upchurch went 2-for-3 at the plate with one run

scored as well. Also this past week, Upchurch charted a career-high three RBI's against Quincy at the Rebel Spring Games in Florida.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Strever posted a new career high with 8.1 innings pitched against Palm Beach Atlantic on Mar. 10 at the Rebel Spring Games in Florida. The Huskies ended up dropping a heart-breaker to PBA by a score 1-2 in nine innings.

BAT 'EM IN: St. Cloud State's first year outfielder Sarah Nohlenberg (Cottage Grove) tabbed a career-high two runs batted in against No. 6 Winona State on Mar. 14 in a big 5-0 shutout victory.

EARLIER THIS SEASON: The Huskies took the field against Bemidji State earlier this season on Mar. 1 at the Husky Dome Invite and shutout the Beavers 2-0. Brit Krieg earned the victory from the circle, going 7.0 innings after striking out five BSU batters and giving up just one hit in the top of the seventh inning to give up the no-hitter.

STREAK STOPS AT SIX: St. Cloud State's longest win streak of the season stopped at six games. From Mar. 1-Mar. 9, the Huskies went 6-0, garnering wins over Bemidji State, Southwest Minnesota, Holy Family, Wilmington, Stonehill and Ashland.

FACING THE TOP-25: The Huskies have garnered two wins this season over top-25 ranked teams. Those wins came against #10 C.W. Post on Mar. 9 (9-2) and #6 Winona State on Mar. 14 (5-0). This season, SCSU is 2-6 overall against top-25 teams.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

U'Ren

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren has an impressive 439-215 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
