LET'S GO OUTSIDE AND PLAY: The Huskies are scheduled to hit the dirt this week when they host a doubleheader with Upper Iowa (3-16) on Wednesday Mar. 26 at Selke Field. Game times are set for 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm. Then for the weekend the Huskies will be in Winona, Minn. for the Winona State University Invitational on Mar. 29-30. SCSU opens up on the 29th with UW-Parkside (11-6) at 2:00 pm and follow with the host Winona State (10-6) at 4:00 pm. The Huskies close play on Saturday with a pair of game with Lewis University (18-8) at 10:00 am and noon.

THE RECORD: St. Cloud State is currently 25-4 overall in 2008 and 0-0 in the North Central Conference.



HUSKIES GO 4-0 ON THE WEEKEND: On Mar. 21 and 22 the Huskies hosted Mayville State and Valley City State respectively, for a pair of double-headers. In the Mayville State series SCSU cruised to a pair of 8-0 wins. In the first match-up the Huskies scored three runs in the third to break open the game and went on to add insurance in each inning before the game ended 8-0 in the sixth. In the closer with MSU, Jenny Gensch and Sara Sbragia each hit two-run first inning home runs as SCSU ran out to an 4-0 lead and didn't stop until the game ended 8-0 in the fifth. The scoring didn't come so easy against Valley City State, but the Huskies made up for it with timely hitting and great pitching. Kaity Strever pitched six scoreless innings en route to the 4-1 game one win and Cassandra Dyck was scoreless through four before giving up her first run in the fifth. A scare came in the seventh when the Vikings hit a two-run home run in the top of the seventh before SCSU secured the 4-3 win.

QUALITY START: At 25-4 the Huskies are off to their second best start under head coach Paula U'Ren. The best came in just U'Ren's third year with the Huskies, in 2000. That spring SCSU ran off 32 victories before the lost their fifth game, including 11 straight to start the season. At season's end the Huskies had amassed a 41-10 record. #15 national ranking, fourth place finish in the NCC, third place finish in the NCC tournament and a berth in the NCAA Regional playoffs.

THREE ROUND TRIPPERS: In game two of the Mayville State double-header the Huskies had three different players hit home runs. Gensch and Sbragia hit home runs of the normal variety, with the ball landing on the far side of the fence. However Kelly Laas provided a little extra excitement, when she sprinted around the bases making the first of her career, an in the park home run. The three home runs in a game ties a SCSU season high.

AVERAGE IT OUT: The Huskies are batting .360 as a team almost half way through the season. There is still a long way to go, but at this pace they would set a new record for team batting average, breaking the mark of .325 set in 2002.

CAREER YEAR: Gensch hit her 15th homer of the season over the weekend and with over 30 games left to play, she sits just two long balls shy of tying Brook Gentzler's ('04) single season record of 17 set in 2003. Her 46 RBI this season are also not far from Gentzler's single season record of 54 set the same season.

9 K'S: First year pitcher Kassandra Dyck recorded the third and fourth wins of her young career over the weekend, and in the process set a new season high when she struck out nine VCSU batters. Her nine strikeouts against the Vikings paved the way for her fourth when on the year. Just one night earlier she threw a five inning gem, shutting out Mayville State. She faced just two over the minimum, scattering two hits while striking out four.

NCC WEEKLY HONORS: On Mar. 18 the North Central Conference handed out their awards from the previous week, and Jenny Gensch and Kaity Strever were named player and pitcher of the week respectively. In two wins over Pitt State (4-3) and Missouri Southern State (8-0) Gensch went 4-8 with three runs scored, four RBI and two home runs as well as a stolen base. In the same two games, throwing from the circle, Strever pitched 12.0 innings earning two wins and gave up no earned runs. Each player shared the honor, Gensch with Casie Hanson of North Dakota and Strever with Meghan Teal of Minnesota State.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record on a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
