**CHANGE IN THIS WEEK'S VENUES:** St. Cloud State will continue Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference competition this week playing host to No. 22 Minnesota State on Wednesday, April 1, at Selke Field. The first pitch of the twin bill is slated for 1 p.m. Due to inclement weather in Minnesota and the field conditions farther north, SCSU's away doubleheaders against MSU Moorhead and Minnesota Crookston on April 4-5 have been moved instead to Selke Field in St. Cloud. The game times will stay the same, with Saturday's games starting at 1 p.m. and Sunday's games starting at 12 p.m.

**THE RECORD:** The Huskies are 14-21 overall and 1-3 in NSIC competition.

**FACING THE TOP-25:** The Huskies are 2-6 overall this season against top-25 teams, and will play host to #22 Minnesota State this Wednesday, April 1. The two wins this season garnered over top-25 ranked teams came against #10 C.W. Post on Mar. 9 (9-2) and #6 Winona State on Mar. 14 (5-0).

**EARLIER THIS SEASON AGAINST THE MAVS:** St. Cloud State dropped a tough 3-5 loss to Minnesota State earlier this season during the Husky Dome Invitational on Feb. 28. SCSU's Emily Edgerton went 2-for-2 at the plate with one walk and one RBI. The Wausau, Wis., native also had five putouts in the field and was a perfect 1-for-1 in stolen base attempts.

**OPENING WEEKEND OF NSIC ACTION:** St. Cloud State softball improved to 14-21 overall after going 1-3 this past weekend against Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State to open Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference action for the first time in school history on Mar. 28-29.

**UMD RESULTS:** The Huskies dropped two heart-breakers to Minnesota Duluth on Mar. 28, dropping the first game 5-6 in the Husky Dome and the second game 2-7 in extra innings.

**BSU RESULTS:** St. Cloud State earned a twin bill split against Bemidji State on Mar. 29, dropping the first game 2-6 and retaliating with a 5-0 shutout victory in the night cap to get back on the winning track.

### STREVER LEADS HUSKIES PAST BEAVERS:

After dropping the first game on Sunday, Mar. 29, to Bemidji State, the Huskies Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.), threw a three-hit complete game gem to get the Huskies back in the win column. She held the guest Beavers off the board for her fourth shutout of the season, and seventh win. Strever faced just four over the minimum while allowing only three hits and fanning a season high seven batters.

### UPCHURCH MOVIN' ON UP:

Sophomore Melanie Upchurch had a strong showing against Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State on Mar. 28-29, swinging for a .429 hitting percentage and posting a team-best six hits, along with her eighth career triple. The outfielder also had a team-high .571 slugging percentage in the past four games and totaled two RBI's and a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage.

### LAAS CONTINUES TO BE MORE:

Kelly Laas continues to lead the Huskies at the plate, hitting .416 in 33 games played. The sophomore native of Frankfort, Ill., also has a team-high .450 on base percentage, 22 runs scored and 47 hits in 2009.

### MATCHING A CAREER-HIGH:

SCSU's Sarah Nohrenberg matched a career-best two RBI's against Minnesota Duluth on Mar. 28.

### AT THE HELM IN '09:

The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

### LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009:

For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

**COACH U'REN'S CORNER:** Paula U'Ren has an impressive 440-218 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
