2008 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: March 31, 2008

ROAD WARRIORS: This week the Huskies tackle a grueling stretch that sees them play six games in a three day span in three different cities. It all starts when SCSU travels to Aberdeen, S.D. for a pair of games against Northern State (2-14) on Apr. 3 at 2:00 and 4:00 pm. The following day on Apr. 4, SCSU is in Sioux Falls, S.D. to for a double-dip with Augustana (11-10) at noon and 2:00 pm before wrapping up the road trip in Mankato on Apr. 5, for their last set of games with Minnesota State (20-12) at 1:00 and 3:00 pm. The Huskies were scheduled for a doubleheader at Concordia-St. Paul on Apr. 1, but the games were cancelled due to weather conditions.

CONFERENCE OPENER: When the Huskies take on Augustana and Minnesota State on Apr. 4 & 5, it will mark the opening of the final season for SCSU in the North Central Conference. Last season the Huskies and Vikings tied for fourth in the league with a 5-7 record, while the Mavericks won the regular season title at 10-1, before winning the tournament title as well.

THE RECORD: St. Cloud State is currently 26-7 overall in 2008 and 0-0 in the NCC.

LAST WEEKS RESULTS: The Huskies were in Winona over the weekend (Mar. 29-30) for the WSU Round Robin Tournament with Lewis University, UW-Parkside and Winona State. In the first day of action the Huskies dropped their first contest, 0-1 to UW-Parkside but rebounded with an 8-5 win over Lewis. In a rematch with Lewis on the second day of play, SCSU fell to the Flyers 1-9, and then also dropped a close 0-3 contest with host Winona State to close out the weekend.

TOURNEY RESULTS: Lewis posted the weekend's best record, going 3-1 losing only to the Huskies. Winona State and UW-Parkside each finished 2-2, including a split in the two games played between them. Finally the Huskies wrapped up the weekend 1-3.

TOP-25 WIN: Lewis came into the weekend ranked #24 in Division II, and with their win, the Huskies knock off a top-25 opponent for the first time since they beat #15 Shippensburg 4-1 on Mar. 10 of last season. The Huskies scored eight runs in the win but it was Sara Sbragia who knocked in the game winner with her two-run double in the fifth. With the score tied 4-4 Sbragia stepped up to the plate with two outs and runners on second and third before sending the ball to left center allowing Kelly Laas and Ashley Homan to score.

SAVE ME: In the win over Lewis, Heather Trobec entered the game in the bottom of the fifth with a runner on first and her team clinging to a one-run lead. Trobec proceeded to shut down all three batters she faced in the inning and gave up just one hit each in the sixth and seventh innings to earn the rare three inning save.

PITCHERS DUEL: In their first game of the weekend the Huskies Kaity Strever locked up in a pitchers duel with UW-Parkside's Meagan Shimkus and each player came into the game as the reigning pitcher of the week in their respective conference. Strever was dominant scattering just four hits and allowing only one unearned run. However Shimkus was just a step ahead, no-hitting the Huskies and facing just four over the minimum to earn the 1-0 victory.

THIRTY-FOUR AND TWO THIRDS: In the first day of the tournament Kaity Strever had a pair of streaks snapped. By giving up the one run to UW-Parkside her scoreless streak was halted at 22 consecutive innings. The run was unearned however maintaining her streak of not allowing an earned run. The streak began on Mar. 7 and continued into the second inning of the game with Lewis. Before it was over Strever had amassed 34.2 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to cross the plate.

NATIONAL LEADERS: When the NCAA released their first weekly national statistics report on Mar. 25, there were several Huskies ranked among the nations best as of game played through 3/23. SCSU was led by Jenny Gensch who led the nation in two categories with 0.52 home runs per game and a slugging percentage of 1.112. Rachel Haines has the fewest strikeouts in the country with just one in 99 at bats, and Katie Hendrickson leads the nation with five sacrifice flies. In the circle Kaity Strever is number one, averaging just 0.06 walks per seven innings.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN: Sophomore hurler Kaity Strever won her second consecutive NCC Pitcher of the Week accolade on Mar. 25 last week. Strever was solid from the circle again earning two wins and a save as the Huskies went 4-0 on the weekend. In 13.0 innings pitched Strever allowed just nine hits while striking out 14 and giving up just two walks. Strever shared the honor with Heather Stemper of Minnesota Duluth.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record on a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
