THIS WEEK'S SCHEDULE: Due to field conditions, the St. Cloud State University softball doubleheader originally scheduled for Tuesday, Apr. 7, against Southwest Minnesota State University, has been pushed back one day to Wednesday, Apr. 8, at Selke Field. The same start time of 2 p.m. is still scheduled. At the end of the week, the Huskies are set to head to St. Paul for a non-conference doubleheader against Concordia University, St. Paul on Friday, Apr. 10. Those games are slated for 3/5 p.m. The following day on Saturday, Apr. 11, the Huskies will then play host to the Golden Bears for an NSIC twin bill at Selke Field, set to start at 2 p.m.

THE RECORD: The Huskies are 18-21 overall and 5-3 in NSIC competition.

EARLIER THIS SEASON: The Huskies faced both Southwest Minnesota State University and Concordia University, St. Paul earlier this season during the Husky Dome Tournaments in February. St. Cloud State edged SMSU, 6-5, and dropped their contest against CU by a score of 1-7.

FIRST IN SCHOOL HISTORY: Led by Sarah Stalker and Nicole Brandenburg, the Huskies garnered their first Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference sweep in school history over Minnesota State University Moorhead on Friday, Apr. 3 in the Husky Dome by scores of 4-3 and 11-2 (5 innings).

KEEPING THE STREAK ALIVE: St. Cloud State softball extended its win streak to five games, the second longest of the season, after posting two crucial sweeps over MSU Moorhead and Minnesota, Crookston this past weekend to improve to 18-21 overall and 5-3 in the NSIC.

CAREER DAY FOR BRANDENBURG: Nicole Brandenburg (Grafton, Wis.) had a career day on Apr. 3 as she helped boost the Huskies to the 11-2 victory in game two of the NSIC doubleheader against MSU Moorhead. The first baseman blasted the first two homers of her young collegiate career to amass a team-best six runs batted in, which also marks a personal game

high for Brandenburg.

EMILY "EDGES" THE GOLDEN EAGLES: Sophomore catcher Emily Edgerton hit her first homerun of the season on Apr. 5, and had four total RBI's as the Huskies swept Minnesota, Crookston in the Husky Dome. Her homerun marked the third of her collegiate career and her three RBI's in the first game against UMC marked a new career single game best.

ANOTHER SHUTOUT FOR STREVER: Kaity Strever went 2-0 this past week from the circle to continue NSIC competition, pitching 14.0 innings and garnering a team best 1.50 ERA. The junior pitcher pitched two complete games, one against MSU Moorhead and one against Minnesota, Crookston, and went on to gain her fourth shutout of the season against UMC in an 11-0 victory. Strever allowed just two hits against the Golden Eagles, and none after the third inning. On the weekend, Strever struck out five opponents and improved her season record to 9-9.

LIZZY IN A TIZZY: Lizzy Dwyer played a crucial role as the designated player in the past four games, leading the Husky squad with a .571 batting average and charting eight hits against MSU Moorhead and Minnesota, Crookston. The junior slap-hitter added her fifth double of the season, three runs scored and three runs batted in as well, all while posting a .643 slugging percentage.

CAREER BEST FOR DOOLEY: First year Jackie Dooley swung for a career best three hits against Minnesota, Crookston on Apr. 5, 2009.

MAVERICK TWIN BILL RESCHEDULED: St. Cloud State's doubleheader against Minnesota State University Mankato, originally scheduled for Wednesday, Apr. 1, has now been tentatively rescheduled for Tuesday, Apr. 28, at Selke Field.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

U'Ren

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren has an impressive 444-218 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
