## 2008 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: April 7, 2008

**THE FRIENDLY CONFINES:** For the first time all season the Huskies get to host a game outside, at Historic Selke Field. On April 9, Southwest Minnesota State (20-6) visits for a mid-week doubleheader at 2:00 and 4:00 pm. The home stand is short lived though, as SCSU hops back on the bus to Maryville, Mo., where Northwest Missouri State (21-12) is hosting the Northwest Classic Apr. 12-13. SCSU will start with the host at 11:00 am on Apr. 12, and will continue with games against Pittsburg State (16-20) at 3:00 pm, and Fort Hays State (25-19) at 5:00 pm. In the second day of action SCSU matches up with Washburn (22-20) at 11:00 am, and tangles again with Fort Hays State at 1:00 pm.

**CONFERENCE CALL:** After the first weekend of action the Huskies stand at 2-2, and in fourth place in the North Central Conference.

**THE RECORD:** St. Cloud State is currently 28-9 overall in 2008 and 2-2 in the NCC.

**LAST WEEKS RESULTS:** Playing an abbreviated week after four games were cancelled, the Huskies jumped into conference play against Augustana on Apr. 4 and Minnesota State on Apr. 5. In two games against the Vikings, SCSU scored a pair of victories with a 2-1 win, followed up by a 6-1 victory. The next day against the Mavericks, the tables turned as SCSU fell in both games 2-9 and 3-5. The games scheduled for Apr. 1 and 3 versus Concordia-St. Paul and Northern State respectively, will not be made up.

**QUALITY COMPETITION:** The Huskies have played, and will play, some of the top teams from around the North Central Region. This past weekend they matched up against the #10 team in the region, Minnesota State, which included a tough 5-3 loss when the Huskies held the lead late. In the week ahead the Huskies host Southwest Minnesota State who enters the week as the #1 team in the North Central, before heading to the Northwest Classic this weekend where they will meet up with Northwest Missouri State and Washburn who are currently the #2 and #8 teams respectively. The Mustangs are currently riding a 10 game win streak while NW Missouri State has won seven of their last 10. Washburn enters the week having dropped four of their past five, after winning 15 of the 16 games prior.

**SWEEP OF AUGIE:** The Huskies got the weekend started off on the right foot with a 2-0 sweep of Augustana in both team's conference opener. Kaity Strever threw a one run gem in the first game for her 19th win and Jenny Gensch knocked in both runs as SCSU squeaked out the 2-1 win. In game two, Heather Trobec started and pitched 4.0 shutout innings allowing just three hits to earn her fifth win. At the plate Lizzy Dwyer went 3-4 and Sara Sbragia hit a two-run double in the third that broke the game open for the Huskies.

**GENSCH CLOSERS IN ON RECORD:** After the weekend, Gensch sits with 50 RBI on the 2008 season and is just four away from the SCSU single season record of 54 set by 2003 by Brooke Gentzler.

**BIG WEEKEND FOR DWYER:** In addition to her 3-4 game versus Augustana, the sophomore slap hitter managed at least one hit in each game of the weekend which also included a 2-4 day in the final game against Minnesota State where she knocked in a career high two RBI. In the four games she finished 7-14 with two RBI, one run scored and a stolen base. It is also the third time this season Dwyer has had four or more consecutive games with a hit.

**MINNESOTA STATE MAKES COMEBACK:** After falling 9-2 in the first game, the Huskies came back to take a 3-0 lead in the top of the fourth in game two. The Mavericks scored twice in the bottom of the fourth to come within one at 3-2, and in the fifth brought home three runs to take a 5-3 lead that would hold up for the win. Winless in their last four against Minnesota State, the Huskies have not beaten MSU since sweeping a double header on Apr. 8, 2006.

**ALL-TIME LIST:** With nine at bats over the weekend, Gensch moved into ninth place on the SCSU all-time charts, and with 603 at-bats in her career is one of just nine players ever with over 600.

**WALK AWAY JOE:** The Huskies earned a combined 17 walks over the weekend, their best four game stretch this season.

### 2007 NCC Champions: Minnesota State

**COACH U'REN'S CORNER:** Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record on a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
