2008 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: April 14, 2008

CONFERENCE CALL: In six games this week the Huskies play three doubleheaders against conference foes. Things begin on Tuesday Apr. 15 when SCSU travels to North Dakota for a doubleheader at 2:00 and 4:00 pm. After two days off the Huskies have back to back home dates on Apr. 18 and 19. First is a doubleheader with Nebraska-Omaha at noon and 2:00 followed the next day with two games against South Dakota scheduled for 1:00 and 3:00 pm.

THE RECORD: St. Cloud State is currently 29-10 overall in 2008 and 2-2 in the NCC with six NCC games on the schedule for this week.

LAST WEEKS RESULTS: A very abbreviated week began, and ended, with a doubleheader against the seventh ranked team in Division II, Southwest Minnesota State, and after dropping the first game 1-0, the Huskies earned the split with a 4-3 win in game two. The Huskies were scheduled to play five games over the weekend in the Northwest Classic hosted by Northwest Missouri State University in Maryville, Mo. However, rain, snow and poor field conditions caused the cancellation of the entire tournament and the Huskies were out five more games.

BACK ON THE SCHEDULE: Two games that have been put back on the SCSU schedule are contests with Upper Iowa University originally scheduled for March 26. The doubleheader, which was supposed to be the Huskies opener at Selke Field, has been rescheduled for Thursday April 24 at 2:00 and 4:00 pm at Historic Selke Field.

BIG WIN: Southwest Minnesota State came into their doubleheader with the Huskies riding a 10 game win streak that was stretched to 11 after their game one win. Ranked seventh in the Nation and first in the North Central Region, the Mustangs fell for the first time since Mar. 21 when the Huskies earned the 4-3 win. Kaity Strever threw the complete game and Jenny Gensch started the scoring with a two-run home run in the first inning. SCSU went up 4-1 in the third, but the Mustangs battled back within a run at 4-3 after the top of the fourth. Strever dominated from there on giving up just one SMSU hit in the final three innings as she earned her 20th win and the Huskies knocked of #7 Southwest Minnesota State.

20 GAME WINNER: By winning her 20th game on Apr. 9 over Southwest Minnesota State, sophomore pitcher Kaity Strever improves her season record to 20-5. She also becomes the Huskies first 20 game winner since 2004 when Nicole Webb finished with a 30-8 record. The SCSU record for pitching wins in a season is 36 set by Karissa Hoehn 1999.

TROBEC WITH EXCELLENT OUTING: Sophomore hurler Heather Trobec may have suffered the loss in the Huskies first game with SMSU, but in it she had arguably her best outing of the season. In the first complete game of her career, Trobec gave up just one run while walking three and scattering nine hits. When the Mustangs scored in the sixth inning she gave up just three hits as SMSU worked the runner across the plate. Trobec gave up two hits to the Mustangs in the second and no more than one hit in any other inning.

CAREER HIGH FOR HENDRICKSON: In the first game with Southwest Minnesota State, first year catcher Katie Hendrickson led the Huskies with three hits. The total ties a career high and is just the second time in her young career that she has had a three hit game.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: The Huskies finally were able to crack the top-10 of the North Central region poll this past week when they came in at number nine with a 22-9 Division II record and a 14-5 in-region record. The jump came after the Huskies opened North Central Conference play at 2-2 with two wins over Augustana and two losses to Minnesota State. MSU sits at #8 in this week's poll. Along with SCSU and MSU, Nebraska-Omaha is the highest-ranking NCC team at number five.

CHAMPIONSHIP REUNION: When the Huskies host South Dakota on Apr. 19, they will be celebrating the 10 year anniversary of SCSU's 1998 North Central Conference Championship team. The Championship was the first of three for head coach Paula U'Ren and came in her first season at the helm. Many players are expected to return from a team that went 42-14 overall and ended their season in the Championship game of the North Central Region Tournament.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories

also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record and a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
