THIS WEEK'S SCHEDULE: St. Cloud State softball will play host to No. 13-ranked Winona State University on Wednesday, Apr.15, for an NSIC doubleheader at Selke Field. The first pitch is scheduled for 2 p.m. This upcoming weekend, the Huskies will head on the road for the first time in conference action this season. On Saturday (Apr. 18), SCSU will play at U-Mary, and on Sunday (Apr. 19) Northern State University will play host to the Huskies.

THE RECORD: The Huskies are 18-27 overall and 5-7 in NSIC competition.

EARLIER THIS SEASON: The Huskies faced both the University of Mary and Winona State earlier this season in non-conference action. St. Cloud State edged dropped its game against U-Mary, 5-7, at the Husky Dome Classic in February. In mid-March, the Huskies hosted nationally ranked Winona State and split with the Warriors, surrendering the first game 1-9, and retaliating with a 5-0 shutout win in the second stint.

LAST WEEK'S RESULTS: St. Cloud State softball dropped six games last week to NSIC opponents, (SMSU, CU) with two of those games being recorded as non-conference contests against the Golden Bears.

EDGERTON ON A ROLL: Emily Edgerton (Wausau, Wis.) led the way for the Huskies last week, starting in all six games at the catching position and batting .429 at the plate with a team best .529 on-base percentage. She was also second on the squad with six hits and two runs scored.

GATZ IN THE STARTING BLOCKS: First year pitcher Angie Gatz (Winsted) made her first career start in the Cardinal and Black on Friday, Apr. 10, going 4.2 innings before suffering her first loss from the circle.

LASS IN THE LEAD: Kelly Laas, SCSU's right fielder, currently leads the Huskies with a .393 batting average, 29 runs scored, 57 hits and is tied for a team best 13 stolen bases.

COMPARABLE ON THE MOUND: SCSU's junior pitcher Kaity Strever and first year pitcher Brit Krieg are very comparable in numbers this season. Both have nine wins from the circle and have ERA's below a 4.0. Although Krieg has appeared in seven more games, both have 21 starts, with Krieg pitching just six more innings than Strever this season.

SNAP THE STREAK: The Huskies are looking to snap their six-game slide on Wednesday, Apr. 15, against Winona State.

VERSUS RANKED TEAMS: The Huskies are 2-6 overall this season against top-25 teams, and will play host to #13 Winona State this Wednesday, April 15. The two wins this season garnered over top-25 ranked teams came against #10 C.W. Post on Mar. 9 (9-2) and #6 Winona State on Mar. 14 (5-0).

FIRST INNING BLISS: The Huskies are only out-scoring their 2009 opponents in the first inning, 29-25.

COUNT 'EM FOR STALKER: Sophomore short stop Sarah Stalker is at the helm of her Husky teammates with three homeruns and 29 runs batted in this season.

HOME AND AWAY MARKS: St. Cloud State is 6-15 at home this season. The Huskies are 5-4 when playing as the visiting team.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the program. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.), sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren has an impressive 444-224 overall career mark in her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
