SCSU (23-17, 2-2 NCC) will play games against Conc.-SP, MN-Duluth, Minnesota State and Augustana this week.



HUSKIES TO PLAY CRUCIAL NCC GAMES THIS WEEK: The St. Cloud State softball team (23-17, 2-2 NCC) will play host to Concordia-St. Paul for a non-conference doubleheader on Tuesday, April 19th, at historic Selke Field. The first pitch will be thrown at 3:00 p.m. The following day, on April 20th, the Huskies will head to Duluth for a conference tilt with Minnesota Duluth. Those games are set to begin at 3:30 p.m. SCSU will wrap up the week with conference games against Minnesota State on Friday, April 22, and against Augustana College on Saturday, April 23. Both doubleheaders will be played at Selke Field with starting game times at noon.

SCSU SWEEPS SOUTH DAKOTA STATE: The SCSU softball team hung on to win two one-run games over the South Dakota State University Jackrabbits on Friday, April 15th, in non-conference play. The Huskies battled back in the bottom of the fifth inning in the first game to get the 3-2 victory. In the second game of the day, SCSU's Ashley Homan came through in the clutch with a game-winning solo homerun in the bottom of the sixth inning to lift the Huskies to the 4-3 win. In game one, SCSU's pitcher, Lacey Trossbach, would hold on to the victory as she retired six of seven Jackrabbit batters in the last two innings and improved her overall pitching record this season to 13-10. For the game, senior Jess Swartout led all hitters with two hits, including two singles. Senior outfielder Abby Velta led the Huskies in the RBI category with two. In the second game of the doubleheader, SCSU pulled out the win with a sixth-inning solo homerun from first year Ashley Homan. The Jackrabbits would go on to take the 3-1 lead in the top of the fourth inning. SCSU's Lacey Trossbach relieved Stef Schroeder, who had pitched 3.0 innings in the second game. The Huskies answered the call however and scored two runs of their own in the bottom of the fourth inning to keep the game tied at 3-3. Homan started the rally with a single, which led to Jessica Swartout's two-run homerun. Swartout's homerun marked her third of the season. For the game, Homan led all hitters with two hits, including her fourth homerun of the season which sealed the 4-3 victory for the Huskies.

SCSU AT CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL TOURNAMENT: SCSU lost three games at the Concordia-St. Paul Tournament on Sunday, April 17. In the first game of the tournament the Huskies lost 9-6 to Minnesota Duluth. The Huskies completed the day with an 11-3 loss to Winona State and a 4-3 loss to Minnesota State, Moorhead. In their first game, Megan Staton had three hits in the game and first year shortstop Jenny Gensch had a triple in the game. Against Winona State, Abby Velta, Megan Fuches and Jessica Swartout all had two hits in the loss for the Huskies, including a three-run double in the first inning for Swartout. Against Minnesota State-Moorhead, Abby Velta, Ashley Homan and Abby Augdahl all had two hits in the game. SCSU's catcher, Jess Preiner, added one hit and two RBIs.

HUSKIES VERSUS NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE OPPONENTS:

This week the Huskies will face three North Central Conference opponents in Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State, and Augustana College. This season marks the first year that Minnesota Duluth has been a part of the NCC. In 2004, the Huskies went 2-1 against the Bulldogs, as they lost 5-6, and won the other two games by scores of 4-1 and 10-2. Against Minnesota State in 2004, the Huskies shutout the Mavericks in their double-header with two wins; 4-0 and 8-0. Last season against the Augustana College Vikings, the Huskies went 2-1 over the Vikings, including a crucial 2-0 victory over AC in the NCC Tournament Championship game. That win moved the Huskies into the North Central Regional Tournament last season.

In 2005, the Huskies have already matched up against Minnesota Duluth in the Concordia-St. Paul tournament this past weekend. SCSU dropped a tough 6-9 loss to the Bulldogs as look to revenge that loss on Wednesday, April 20th. Minnesota Duluth's record stands at 13-21 as of April 17. The Huskies have not yet faced the Minnesota State Mavericks this season, nor have they faced Augustana College in 2005. Minnesota State's record stands at 22-23, 4-0 NCC and Augustana's record stands at 13-10-1, 3-2-1 NCC.

VELTA AND FUCHES LEADING THE HUSKIES: Senior outfielder Abby Velta continues to lead the Huskies in the hitting category with a .361 batting average. She has started in all 40 games this season, leads the team with 53 hits, four triples, and 73 total bases, and has a 1.000 fielding percentage with 42 putouts. Playing at

third base in her senior season, Megan Fuches has made quite the turnaround from last season's .183 batting average to this season's .336 batting average. Fuches has also started in all 40 games in 2005, is second on the team behind Velta with 128 at bats and 43 hits, and has a fielding percentage of .928 with 47 putouts. Fuches also leads the team in doubles with nine on the season.

HUSKY PITCHING IN 2005: Sophomore pitcher Lacey Trossbach has been the go-to pitcher for the Huskies in 2005. Her season record stands at 14-13 as she has tallied four shutouts and 113 strikeouts in 156.0 innings pitched. Another sophomore pitcher, Meggan Staton, has a season record of 1-1 as she had charted 11 strikeouts in 17.2 innings pitched. Stef Schroeder, a first year pitcher from Pine Island, Minn., has seen 24 appearances for the Huskies in 2005. Schroeder has notched 105.2 innings pitched and 91 strikeouts, along with three shutouts.

SCSU Head Coach Paula U'Ren 8 Seasons of Excellence at SCSU

Paula U'Ren is in her eighth season as head coach at St. Cloud State in 2005, and ranks among in top 9 for winning percent among active Division II coaches.



In her first year with the program, U'Ren brought home SCSU's first NCC championship during 1998. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA DII North Central Regional .

SCSU has since gained NCAA bids in 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 and 2004. In 2003, SCSU added another NCC title and it was 2004 that put the Huskies on the map, as they won the NCC championship for the second year in a row and finished third at the NCAA National Tournament.

In her career, U'Ren owns an impressive 310-106 record as a collegiate coach and she is the school's coaching victory leader.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Sue Becker.

As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-America selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
