2008 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: April 21, 2008

LUCKY ELEVEN: The Huskies pack 11 games into the next seven days including three straight home doubleheaders at Historic Selke Field. First is a match-up with Bemidji State (3-18) on the 22nd at 2:00 and 4:00 pm. Next on the 23rd, the Huskies close out conference play when Minnesota Duluth (15-14) visits at 3:00 and 5:00 pm. The home stand then wraps up on the 24th with Upper Iowa (12-23) at 2:00 and 4:00 pm. The UIU set is a make up date from Mar. 26. Finally on Saturday and Sunday the Huskies travel to North Mankato for the MSU/Microtel Inn & Suites Classic, Apr. 26-27. In day one of action the Huskies meet up with Winona State (28-12) at 11:00 am and Missouri Western State (23-25) at 1:00 pm. In day two they close with three games, starting with Fort Hays State (29-21) at 9:00 am, followed by Wayne State (Neb.) (26-18) at 1:00 pm and capped off with Concordia-St. Paul (22-15) at 3:00 pm.

THE RECORD: St. Cloud State is currently 31-14 overall in 2008 and 4-6 in the NCC with their final two NCC games on the schedule this week. The pair of games with Minnesota Duluth will also mark the end to the final season of NCC play for the Huskies.

LAST WEEKS RESULTS: The Huskies went 2-4 in their six games last week, book ended by a pair of big wins. The week began with the offense taking fire against North Dakota, producing a season high 16 runs on their way to a 16-7 victory. North Dakota game back to earn the split with a 8-7 win in game two. The Huskies then met up with league leading Nebraska-Omaha and dropped a pair of tough games 8-0, and after leading 3-1 in the sixth, lost game two 12-5. In the final doubleheader the offense stalled in a 1-0 game one loss to South Dakota, but came back alive for a five run sixth to earn the game two win over the Coyotes 9-6.

REMATCH WEEK: The Huskies meet up this week with five teams they have already played. The first match-up with Bemidji State is rematch of a doubleheader that the Huskies swept 4-1 & 12-0 on Feb. 22 in the Husky Dome. Also under the roof, at the Husky Dome Invite on Feb. 23 the Huskies scored a 7-0 win in their first meeting with Upper Iowa, but one weekend earlier on Feb. 17 at the Husky Dome Classic, the Huskies dropped a 2-1 decision to Concordia-St. Paul. In Fort Meyers, Fla. on Mar. 5, SCSU scored a 5-4 win over Wayne State (Neb.) and at the WSU Round Robin Tournament on Mar. 30, the Huskies fell to host Winona State 3-0.

GRAND SBAGIA: First year first basemen Sara Sbragia led the Huskies to their win over USD with her first career grand slam in the pivotal sixth inning of game two. The Huskies entered the inning down 4-6 after the Coyotes scored twice in the top of the inning to take the lead. After their first two batters flew out, Melanie Upchurch tripled to give the Huskies their first base runner. Two batters later Jenny Gensch singled her home, and after Ashley Homan was hit the bases were loaded for Sbragia. She wasted no time as she took the first pitch she saw and laced it over the left field fence for her first grand slam and seventh home run.

RECORD WATCH: A few milestones were passed, a few more are being closed in on after last weeks action. Two records came from Jenny Gensch who set new SCSU marks for RBI and home runs in a single season. In the 16-7 win over UND, Gensch knocked in three runs which gave her 55 and broke the five year old record of 54 set by Brooke Gentzler in 2003, she currently sits at 58. Two days later in the 12-5 loss to UNO, Gensch hit her 17th home run of the season, which ties her with Gentzler's mark sent in the same season. Also with her seventh home run Sbragia is just one from tying the first year record of eight set by Ashley Homan in 2005, and with 27 RBI this season Sbragia has a shot at the first year mark of 36 set in 2002 by Meghan Fuches. Finally with a .429 batting average, Lizzy Dwyer is just two points off the mark of .431 that was also set by Gentzler in 2003.

HOME RUN HAPPY: Four the fourth time this season the Huskies smashed three home runs in a game. In their 16-7 win over North Dakota, Dwyer, Sbragia, and Sarah Stalker all went deep. For Dwyer and Stalker, it was the first home run of their careers.

SENIOR DAY: When the Huskies host Minnesota Duluth in their NCC finale, it will be senior day, honoring the great four-year careers of Jenny Gensch and Ashley Homan.

NCC PITCHER OF THE WEEK: For the third time this season the Huskies Kaity Strever has been named NCC Pitcher of the Week. This nod came on 4/15, for her performance in pitching the Huskies to a 4-3 win over then seventh ranked Southwest Minnesota State. She allowed just five hits while striking out three and dominated down the stretch allowing just one hit over the final three innings and retired the final eight batters she faced. Strever shares the honor Minnesota State's Samantha Rohr.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories

also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record and a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
