HUSKIES FACE UMD BEFORE HEADING TO MSU CLASSIC: St. Cloud State University's softball team (24-23, 4-6 NCC) will face Minnesota Duluth on Tuesday, April 24, before heading to the MSU, Mankato & Microtel Inn & Suites Classic on Saturday and Sunday, April 28-29. SCSU's North Central Conference doubleheader against UMD is slated for a Noon start in Duluth. The Huskies will face Missouri Western, North Dakota and Concordia-St. Paul on the first day of competition at the MSU & Microtel Classic, then complete the weekend with games against Missouri Southern and Upper Iowa on Sunday.

2007 RECORD: The Huskies are 24-23 overall and 4-6 in the North Central Conference. Since 1969, SCSU has posted an all-time record of 831-496 (.626).

SMSU DOUBLEHEADER CANCELLED: The non-conference doubleheader against Southwest Minnesota State University that was rescheduled for Wednesday, April 25, has been cancelled.

LAST WEEK'S RESULTS: The St. Cloud State University softball team played five doubleheaders last week and posted a 5-4 record in the process.

On Monday, April 16, SCSU's Amanda Chancellor, a sophomore left fielder from Sartell, went 4-for-4 at the plate and knocked in two runs to help boost the Huskies past Bemidji State at the BSU Softball Complex, by a score of 7-3. The second game of the doubleheader was cancelled due to weather. The Huskies split with the University of North Dakota on Tuesday, April 17, at Selke Field. SCSU won the first game 5-2, and UND held on for the 12-9 victory in the second game of the North Central Conference doubleheader. SCSU headed to Moorhead on Thursday, April 19, for a doubleheader against the Minnesota State, Moorhead Dragons. St. Cloud State won the first game 10-5, then lost a heartbreaker in the second game in the bottom of the seventh inning, 8-9.

Over the weekend, head coach Paula U'Ren's Husky squad returned to NCC action with a doubleheader against Minnesota State on Friday, April 20, at Selke Field, and another doubleheader against Augustana on Saturday, April 21. After suffering a sweep to Minnesota State by scores of 0-11 and 4-18, the Huskies rallied against Augustana College the following day, winning both games, 4-3 and 6-4.

TOUCH 'EM ALL KELLY DURKIN: SCSU's sophomore Kelly Durkin had a career week, swinging for five home runs and a team-leading 12 RBIs from April 16-21. Against North Dakota on April 17, Durkin tallied three hits, five RBIs and two runs scored in the second game of the doubleheader, which included her first career grand slam in the first inning. The Shakopee native now has six home runs on the season and is batting .303.

UMD SERIES: Minnesota Duluth and SCSU started playing each other in 1969. UMD currently leads the all-time series 40-34. The Bulldogs are 19-17 overall and 4-3 in the NCC.

U'Ren

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is

in her 10th season as head coach at St. Cloud State in 2006-07. She takes with her perhaps the most successful program at SCSU. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles). U'Ren's 363-146 career record at SCSU ranks 14th among active NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .713. History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament.

At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

A native of Mapleton, Minn., U'Ren owns an impressive 363-146 record as a collegiate coach. She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-America selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs.

2006 St. Cloud State Softball Season Recap

2006 SEASON RECAP: SCSU (33-24, 8-4 NCC/3rd) completed its 2006 season with a third place finish in the NCC Tournament. After tallying a regular season third place finish in the NCC, SCSU recorded wins against South Dakota (5-3), Minnesota Duluth (10-9) and North Dakota (3-1), before dropping games to the eventual tournament champion Augustana (0-3) and nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha (1-4) in the double-elimination NCC Tournament. SCSU's head coach Paula U'Ren continued the season win streak of 30 games and has now managed to achieve over 30 wins in each of her nine seasons here at St. Cloud State. This season marked the second straight season since 2001 that the Huskies had not received an NCAA tournament bid, and just the third time in U'Ren's tenure that SCSU has not been invited to the big dance. The NCC tournament runner-up in 2005, the Huskies won the conference title in 1998, 2003 and 2004. A top NCAA Division II softball power, SCSU owns a 363-146 record under head coach U'Ren since 1998. Over that period of time, SCSU has won three conference titles, one regional title and the Huskies placed third in the nation at the NCAA Division II championships in 2004.
