2008 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Release Date: April 28, 2008

AND DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: The Huskies have hit the home stretch of the season with just one match-up remaining before the NCC Tournament begins in Duluth this weekend. First the Huskies close out the regular season at home with a doubleheader against MSU Moorhead (14-19) on Apr. 30 at 3:00 pm. With the conference season all wrapped up, the Huskies will be the sixth seed when they open the NCC Tournament on May 2, with their opening round opponent being third seeded South Dakota (17-23). Regular season champion and top seeded Minnesota State will receive a first round bye in the double elimination tournament.

THE RECORD: St. Cloud State is currently 33-18 overall in 2008, and they end their final season of NCC play with a 4-8 league mark.

LAST WEEKS RESULTS: The Huskies opened the week with a doubleheader against Bemidji State and after falling in game one 4-1, took game two by the 15-0 score. The following day SCSU hosted Minnesota Duluth in the NCC finale for both schools, but it was UMD who walked away with both wins, taking game one 7-3, and earning the sweep with a 13-7 game two win. Snow across the state Saturday morning caused the cancellation of the first day of the MSU/Microtell Inn & Suites Classic, but the Huskies were able to salvage a pair of games in North Mankato on Apr. 27. Against Concordia-St. Paul the Huskies fell 10-5 but rebounded to beat Wayne State 2-0 before the day was over. For the second time this season, the Huskies doubleheader with Upper Iowa had to be cancelled due to weather. Originally snow in March caused the games to be pushed back, but rain on the 24th caused them to be cancelled completely.

NCC FINALE: The Huskies put a wrap on their tenure NCC this past week. After their two games with Minnesota Duluth, the Huskies record stands at 4-8 in league play in 2008. In 24 seasons in the North Central Conference, SCSU has produced a 152-101 all-time record that includes regular season championships in 2003 and 2004, and tournament titles in 1998, 2003, and 2004. Six times ('88, '90, '91, '99, '01, '05) the Huskies finished as the runner up at the NCC Tournament.

LIVING ON THE EDGERTON: First year catcher Emily Edgerton, made the most of her two at-bats in Wednesday's second game with Minnesota Duluth. After taking over the catching duties in the fifth inning, Edgerton first came to the plate in the sixth. With two runners on base she hit her first career home run to bring the Huskies back with three runs at 7-4. The next inning, Edgerton came to the plate for just the second time in the game and hit her second career home run to finish the day 2-2 with two runs scored and four RBI.

CAREER HIGH FOR STREVER: Despite suffering the loss against Concordia-St. Paul, Kaity Strever managed to strike out a career high eight Golden Bears, bettering her previous mark of seven. In the next game of the day, Strever again got the call again and struck out six Wildcats in seven innings for her 23rd win, 16th complete game, and third shutout of the season.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: In the latest North Central Region poll, the Huskies again came in at the number nine spot, still chasing that elusive eighth and final spot in the regional field. The polls could go out the window, though, if the Huskies can play Cinderella and sweep through the field this weekend at the conference tourney and secure an automatic bid with the NCC Tournament Championship.

SACRIFICE FOR A RECORD: First year outfielder Kelly Laas set a new SCSU record over the weekend with three sac bunts. She now has 17 sac bunts on the year which is one better than the previous mark of 16 set in 1991 by Mary Jensen.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: In their second game against Bemidji State, the Huskies had one of their best offensive performances of the season. In just five innings the Huskies banged out a season high 19 hits and scored 15 runs which was one under their season best. They scored three first inning runs and would go on to score three or more in each of the next three innings for the 15-0 final. Not to be overlooked, though, is the pitching performance of Kassie Dyck who threw her second career shutout and allowed just one hit in her five innings of work.

HAINES BACK AT THE .400 MARK: Junior Rachel Haines went 12-24 the Huskies six games last week to bring her season batting average back to .400. The team leader in hits and at-bats, Haines had been above the .400 mark for much of the season but fell below on Mar. 30. After hovering in the .390's for the last four games, a 2-3 performance against Wayne State put her back over the top. Haines joins the .400 club with Lizzy Dwyer and Jenny Gensch.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 11th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1.

U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU heading into the 2008 season ranks 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranks 37th among active Division II coaches.

In her first year with the program in 1998, U'Ren and the Huskies brought home SCSU's first North Central Conference championship. The Huskies also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament before ending their season with a then-record 42 wins (42-14 overall). In 1999, SCSU posted a 44-14 overall record and also advanced to the championship round of the NCAA regionals. In 2000, the Huskies chalked up their third consecutive 40-win season with a 41-10 record that included another trip to the NCAA regional tournament. The following year in 2001, the Huskies did not receive an NCAA bid but they did post a solid 37-15 overall record and placed second in the always rugged NCC.

The Huskies returned to the dance in 2002, with their fourth NCAA bid under the leadership of U'Ren. SCSU placed second in the league once more and charted a 44-13 overall record. In 2003, SCSU claimed its second NCC title and went on to gain a runner-up spot at the 2003 NCAA Division II North Central Regional. U'Ren also gained personal recognition in 2003 after being awarded the 2003 Ole Odney Award, which is presented each year by Augustana College (S.D.) for outstanding achievement in coaching by an Augustana graduate.

History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

From 1998-2004, U'Ren ranked 41st among active NCAA DII coaches for career wins. In fact, no other NCAA DII coach with eight or less years of coaching experience has had more wins than U'Ren. Last year, the Huskies completed the 2007 season with a 28-30 overall record and a 5-7 mark in the NCC. The Huskies were knocked out of the NCC Championships by North Dakota on May 5, by a score of 6-4.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles.

She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.

Huskies in the NCC Tournament Under U'Ren
