HUSKIES HEAD TO SDSU FOR FINAL REGULAR SEASON GAME: The Huskies will complete regular season action on Thursday, May 3, with a 2 p.m. game against South Dakota State University. The SDSU Jackrabbits are 14-32 overall in 2007.

NCC CHAMPIONSHIPS THIS WEEK: St. Cloud State has been seeded No. 4 in the upcoming North Central Conference Championship tournament on May 4-5 in Sioux Falls, S.D. The Huskies will face No. 5-seeded Augustana College at 12:30 p.m. on Friday, May 4, at Sherman Park. SCSU swept AC earlier this season by scores of 4-3 and 6-4 at Selke Field on April 21. Augustana leads the all-time series 52-29.

Minnesota State was seeded No. 1 after charting a 10-1 NCC record. Nebraska-Omaha is No. 2 with a 7-5 NCC mark and will face No. 7 South Dakota (4-8 NCC) on Friday morning at 10 a.m. Minnesota Duluth took home the No. 3 seed and will face No. 6 North Dakota (4-8 NCC) at 10 a.m. on Friday as well.

Last year at the 2006 NCC Championships, the Huskies finished in third place. After tallying a regular season third place finish in the NCC, SCSU recorded wins against South Dakota (5-3), Minnesota Duluth (10-9) and North Dakota (3-1), before dropping games to the eventual tournament champion Augustana (0-3) and nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha (1-4) in the double-elimination NCC Tournament.

2007 RECORD: The Huskies are 27-27 overall and completed the NCC regular season with a 5-7 mark. Since 1969, SCSU has posted an all-time record of 831-500 (.625).

SCSU GOES 2-3 AT MSU & MICROTEL CLASSIC: SCSU's softball team (27-27, 5-7 NCC) completed the MSU, Mankato & Microtel & Suites Classic on Sunday, April 29, with a 6-1 win over Missouri Southern and a 3-4 loss to Upper Iowa University. The Huskies went 2-3 overall in the two-day Classic at Caswell Park in North Mankato on Saturday and Sunday, April 28-29. The other Husky win of the weekend came against North Dakota on Saturday, 5-4. SCSU dropped the other two games on Saturday to Missouri Western (3-7) and Concordia-St. Paul (2-3).

Olivia Graham led the Huskies over the weekend with a .455 batting average. The junior catcher and third base player committed no errors in the field and went 5-for-11 at the plate with three runs scored.

GO GENSCH: Junior short stop Jenny Gensch is atop the Huskies line up with a .331 overall batting average, 14 doubles, 43 runs scored and 36 RBIs in 2007. The Apple Valley native ranks second on the team with 53 hits and six triples.

HUSKIES IN THE NCC: Jenny Gensch, Ashley Homan and Rachel Haines each are ranking in the top-10 of NCC categories. Gensch is fifth in runs scored per game (0.80), third in doubles (0.26), 10th in RBIs per game (0.67), tied for third in stolen bases per game (0.35), and is first in walks per game (0.46).

Haines ranks ninth in runs scored per game (0.72), is tied for third in stolen bases per game (0.35), ranks sixth with 3.50 at bats per game and is eight with 3.85 plate appearances per game.

Homan is tied for sixth in doubles per game (0.22) and ranks fourth in walks per game (0.43).

The trio of Huskies has combined for 145 hits in 2007 and 116 runs scored.

With not being ranked in the North Central Region, the Huskies need to win the NCC Championship tournament out-right to earn a berth to the NCAA Regionals on May 10-13.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren is in her 10th season as head coach at St. Cloud State in 2006-07. She takes with her perhaps the most successful program at SCSU. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles). U'Ren's 363-146 career record at SCSU ranks 14th among active NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .713. History was made during the 2004 season, as U'Ren led SCSU to a first place finish at the NCAA Division II North Central Regional tournament. At the 2004 NCAA Division II National Championships in Altamonte Springs, Fla., U'Ren's troops marched to a third place finish - thus marking the highest finish at the national level in team history.

A native of Mapleton, Minn., U'Ren owns an impressive 363-146 record as a collegiate coach. She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-America selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs.

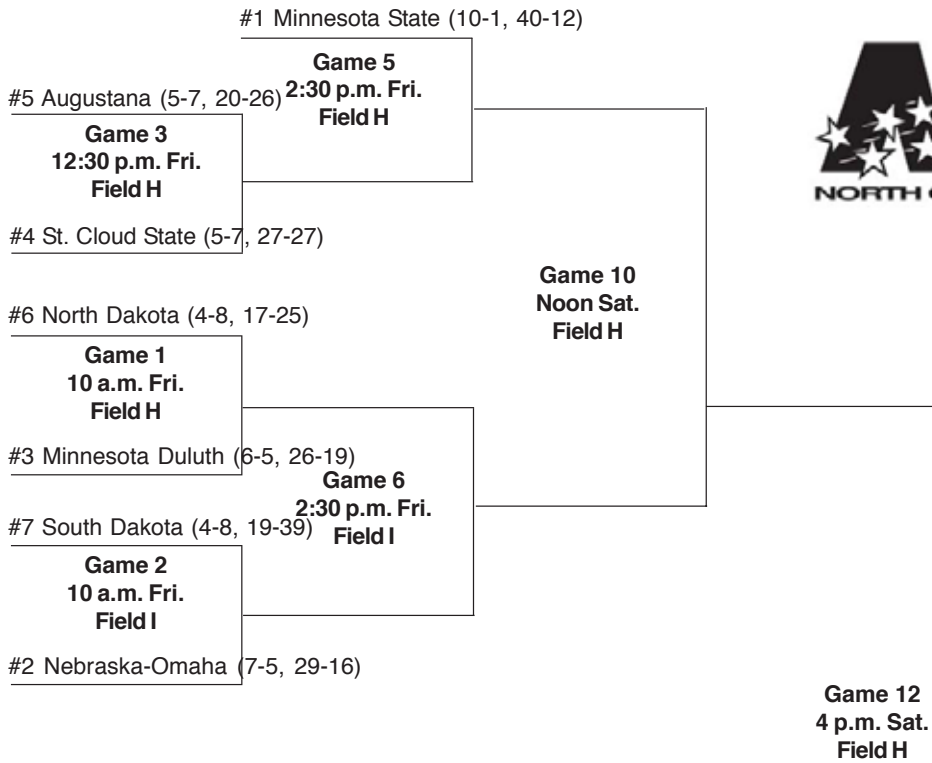


2007 NCC Championship Bracket - Sioux Falls, S.D.

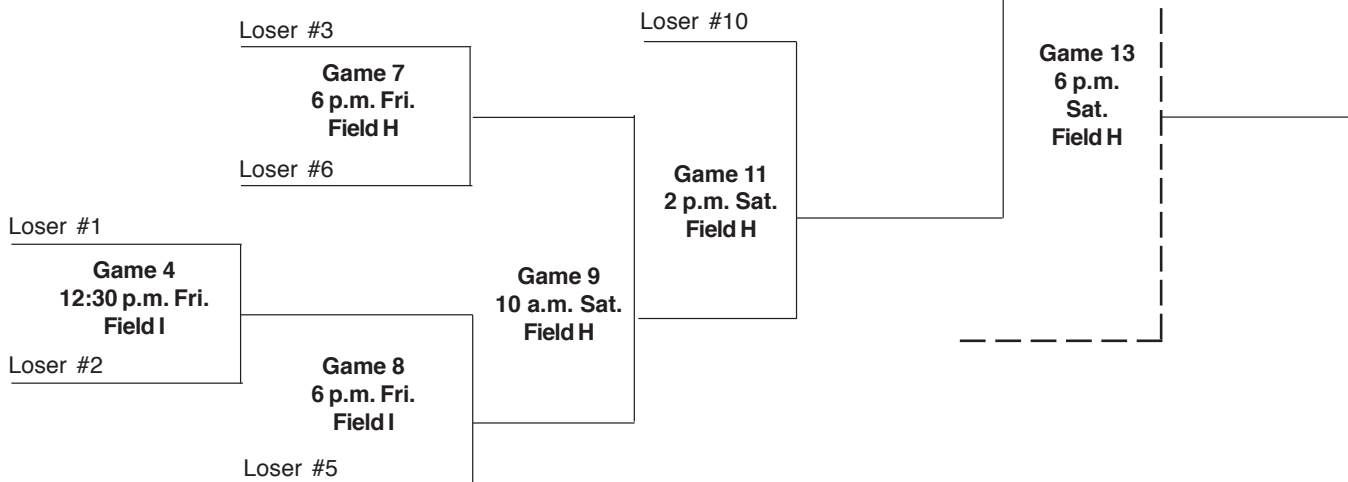

2006 St. Cloud State Softball Season Recap

2006 SEASON RECAP: SCSU (33-24, 8-4 NCC/3rd) completed its 2006 season with a third place finish in the NCC Tournament. After tallying a regular season third place finish in the NCC, SCSU recorded wins against South Dakota (5-3), Minnesota Duluth (10-9) and North Dakota (3-1), before dropping games to the eventual tournament champion Augustana (0-3) and nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha (1-4) in the double-elimination NCC Tournament. SCSU's head coach Paula U'Ren continued the season win streak of 30 games and has now managed to achieve over 30 wins in each of her nine seasons here at St. Cloud State. This season marked the second straight season since 2001 that the Huskies had not received an NCAA tournament bid, and just the third time in U'Ren's tenure that SCSU has not been invited to the big dance. The NCC tournament runner-up in 2005, the Huskies won the conference title in 1998, 2003 and 2004. A top NCAA Division II softball power, SCSU owns a 363-146 record under head coach U'Ren since 1998. Over that period of time, SCSU has won three conference titles, one regional title and the Huskies placed third in the nation at the NCAA Division II championships in 2004.
