ON THE ROAD: St. Cloud State hits the road to Colorado for a non-conference doubleheader against the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs on Thursday, Feb. 19. The following three days, the Huskies will take part in the NSIC/RMAC Crossover on Feb. 20-22.

UCCS BRIEFLY: This marks the first meeting between the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs and St. Cloud State in school history. UCCS is coming off a 22-29 mark in 2008 with a 15-25 record in the RMAC.

HUSKY DOME CLASSIC RESULTS: For the fifth consecutive season, the Huskies played host the Husky Dome Classic on Saturday and Sunday, Feb. 14-15. Participating in the Classic this season was Concordia University-St. Paul, University of Mary, New York Institute of Technology, Lewis University and St. Cloud State University. The Huskies dropped all four games of the Classic with one loss going to U-Mary, two losses to No. 13 Lewis and one loss to Concordia-St. Paul.

SWING AWAY SBAGIA: Sophomore Sara Sbragia led the Huskies in the season opening weekend with a .444 batting average in six games played. The North St. Paul native also leads the squad with eight hits and a .524 on-base percentage.

UPCHURCH ON THE WAY

UP: Another sophomore, Melanie Upchurch, had a stellar weekend at the plate, charting seven hits in 18 at-bats for a .389 batting average and a team-leading .611 slugging percentage. Of note, Upchurch went 2-for-3 against NSIC rival, Concordia University-St. Paul on Sunday, Feb. 15, in the Husky Dome Classic.

HUSKY "FIRSTS": On the mound, first year pitchers Angie Gatz, Brit Krieg and Kristin Jakobsen all made their collegiate debuts in the Husky Dome, with Krieg and Jakobsen earning their first starts in the Cardinal and Black.

AT THE HELM IN '09: The Huskies are coached by 12th-year head coach Paula U'Ren and assisted by Jennifer Bakke, Ashley Partlow and Jenny Gensch. Ashley Homan is serving as a student assistant coach and Kelli Niess is back for her second season as a volunteer student assistant coach.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

FOR 2009: For the second season, the Huskies have incorporated a team leadership council. The St. Cloud State softball team's leadership council is selected by votes of each member of the team and the coaching staff. Each class selects a member to represent their class and the

program. This model was employed last year and it allows for the growth of the leaders on the team throughout all classes. The captains for this year include senior Rachel Haines (Pepin, Wis.), junior Kaity Strever (Laurel, Mont.) sophomores Melanie Upchurch (Waterloo, Iowa) and Sarah Stalker (Hudson, Wis.) and first year Brit Krieg (Hudson, Wis.).

2009 NSIC PRESEASON POLL: Winona State was picked to win the NSIC by the league coaches in their preseason poll for the first time since the 2004 season. St. Cloud State garnered an eighth place vote after receiving 106 votes.

GREAT IN '08: The 2008 Huskies produced their best record since the 2004 season finishing 35-21 overall. In the NCC the Huskies finished 4-8 and in sixth place, and in the NCC Tournament the Huskies went 1-2 to finish in fifth place. Some marquee wins from 2008 included an 8-5 victory on 3/29 over 24th-ranked Lewis, and a 4-3 win on 4/9 over No. 7 Southwest Minnesota State.

COACH U'REN'S CORNER: Paula U'Ren brings an impressive 426-197 overall career mark into her 12th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University softball team in 2008-09. In U'Ren's tenure the Huskies have qualified for the NCAA Regional Tournament six times and have won the North Central Conference playoff championship three times (including the 2003 and 2004 NCC titles).

Heading into the 2008 season last year, U'Ren's 391-176 career record at SCSU ranked 16th all-time among NCAA DII coaches for best winning percentage at .690. Her 391 career victories also ranked 37th among active Division II coaches.

On Sunday, Feb. 24, Coach U'Ren reached a milestone, garnering her 400th career coaching win against the University of Minnesota, Crookston, by a score of 9-1. Coach U'Ren's career mark now stands at 426-197, good for a .684 winning percentage.

She is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. U'Ren received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University. As a graduate student at SCSU, U'Ren served as a graduate assistant coach under Dr. Sue Becker. As a collegiate player at Augustana, U'Ren was named a three-time All-Region, All-NCC and NCAA Division II All-American selection in 1993, 1994 and 1995 and finished among the top 10 players in NCAA Division II softball in batting average, home runs and RBIs. In her tenure at Augie, the Vikings posted a 207-45 record - including a 57-7 record her junior season. In the all-time NCAA Division II records, U'Ren ranks fourth for career RBIs with 192, sixth with 32 career homers and 15th with 41 career doubles. She is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.
