2006 SCSU SOFTBALL NEWS

Upcoming Games:

The Huskies (4-4, 0-0 NCC) play no games this upcoming week. They will prepare for next week's trip to Kissimmee, FL, where they will play 12 games in the Rebel Spring Games.

UPCOMING GAMES: The St. Cloud State softball team will head south to Kissimmee, Florida for the Rebel Spring Games to be held March 5-11. The Huskies will take on 12 opponents over spring break, eight of which the Huskies have played against in the past. New opponents include Philadelphia, Dowling, Bellarmine, and Shippensburg.

2005 RECORD: The Huskies finished the 2005 season with a 34-25 overall record and a mark of 7-5 in the NCC, good for a third place finish. They battled their way to the NCC Championship game, losing to Nebraska-Omaha on May 7 by a score of 6-2. Although the Huskies suffered key injuries during the year and played through miserable weather at time, SCSU's head coach Paula U'Ren still managed to achieve over 30 wins on the season, marking the ninth season in a row that SCSU has won 30 or more games.

TOURNAMENT INSIGHT: The Huskies will once again head south over spring break to play a mess of games in the warm weather of Kissimmee, Florida. At the Rebel Spring Games, SCSU will face 12 competitors over seven days, playing two games each day with one day of rest. Last season in Orlando, Florida, the Huskies went 8-4 in games played. Of the 12 teams the squad will face in Kissimmee, four are teams that SCSU saw last year in Florida, four are teams that SCSU has seen in previous years, and four are teams that the Huskies have never faced. Against teams played last year in the Sunshine State, the Huskies gained wins against Ferris State and Findlay and lost to SIU-Edwardsville and Southern Indiana. Overall against the eight teams that SCSU has seen in the past, the Huskies have won 16 of the 23 games played.

SPLITSVILLE: The Huskies finished the Husky Dome Invite with a 2-2 record, splitting wins and losses for the second consecutive weekend. They went down 0-1 early against Winona State, but made a third inning rally to get back on top 2-1. WSU answered with one run in each of the next three innings and the Huskies were unable to produce more offense, falling 2-4. It was a five-inning scoreless stalemate with MSU, Moorhead in SCSU's second game Saturday afternoon. Jessica Preiner started out the sixth with a walk and advanced to the plate before the inning was up, giving the Huskies a 1-0 advantage, which was the resulting final score. SCSU suffered a tough 8-10 loss to Minnesota State Sunday afternoon. They were up by five runs entering the fifth inning, but allowed the Mavericks eight runs in the fifth and sixth innings. Despite producing nine hits in the game, the Huskies could not defend the field well enough to stop MSU and dropped the game 8-10. SCSU wrapped up the home invitational with a 6-0 win over UW-Superior. They had seven hits and turned two UWS errors into runs. Lacey Trossbach totalled nine strikeouts on her way to her second win of the season.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

HEAD COACH PAULA U'REN: Paula U'Ren begins her ninth season as head coach at St. Cloud State in 2006. The U'Ren era has been filled with success and Paula currently touts a 334-126 career record with the Huskies. Under U'Ren's guidance, the team has won three NCC Championships, has advanced to the NCAA Playoffs six out of the past eight years, and placed third in the 2004 NCAA Div. II National Tournament. None of U'Ren's teams have finished a season below a .575 average. Paula is a 1995 graduate of Augustana College (S.D.), where she majored in Fitness/Exercise Physiology. She received her M.S. in exercise sports science from St. Cloud State University and is a native of Mapleton, Minnesota.

HEAVY HITTERS: SCSU's lone seniors Abby Augdahl (Anchorage, AK) and Jessica Preiner (Stillwater, MN) have taken the reigns of a young team and have shown their counterparts how to take control of the plate. Augdahl and Preiner have each knocked two balls out of the park this season, Augdahl with two homers against Southwest Minnesota State and Preiner with one homer in each of SCSU's Husky Dome tournaments. Augdahl currently leads the Huskies at the plate with a .435 batting average. She has 10 hits in 23 at bats, including four doubles.

Sophomores Ashley Homan (Cottage Grove, MN) and Jenny Gensch (Apple Valley, MN) have also swung for the fences this season, coming up with one homerun each.

HUSKIES TAKE THE FIELD: Leading the Huskies on defense this season are Jessica Preiner, Jenny Gensch, and Olivia Graham (Falcon Heights, MN). At first base, Preiner leads the team in put-outs with 58. Gensch is back at short stop this season, where she has come up with a team high 23 assists. Graham, with 30 put-outs on the season, has spent the majority of her playing time behind the plate.

DUO ON THE RUBBER: With pitcher Meggan Staton (Anoka, MN) out of the rotation for the beginning part of the season, the Huskies will look to junior Lacey Trossbach (Saint Inigoes, MD) and sophomore Stef Schroeder (Pine Island, MN) to share responsibilities on the mound. Both pitchers have made four starts this season and both currently claim a 2-2 record. Trossbach has taken out more batters at the plate (Trossbach: 27 K's, Schroeder: 16 K's), while Schroeder maintains an edge on the ERA (Schroeder: 3.86 ERA, Trossbach: 4.15 ERA).
