SCSU's Eiden Earns NCC Weekly Honor

Sioux Falls, S.D. -- St. Cloud State University's men's diver, junior Ross Eiden (Rosemount), was honored by the North Central Conference today as he was named NCC Diver of the Week.

The distinction came after Eiden took the top spot in one-meter diving at the Husky Invitational this past weekend. Eiden's winning score was 460.10, which also qualified him for nationals as he was 20 points better than the qualifying standard of 440.

He also finished fifth in three-meter diving with a 429.75 score. The Husky men's team finished second in the Invitational meet with a score of 1102.50, just 7.5 back of winner UW-Green Bay at 1110.

Eiden is the first SCSU swimmer or diver to be honored by the NCC this season.

Led by seventh year head coach Jeff Hegle, the SCSU men's and women's swimming and diving teams return to the deck on Saturday, Nov. 10, for the Saint John's/Saint Ben's Invite. Swimming is set to start at 10:30 a.m. at Warner Palaestra Pool on the campus of SJU, and the diving will take place at SCSU's Halenbeck Hall Aquatic Center, beginning at 12:00 p.m.

An NCAA Division II affiliate, St. Cloud State University is a member of the North Central Conference. Founded in 1869, St. Cloud State University is the second largest college in the state of Minnesota with 16,000 students. SCSU's main campus is located on the banks of the Mississippi River in the city of St. Cloud, Minn. - which is located approximately one hour north of Minneapolis-St. Paul.
