Ross Eiden Honored By NCC:

Sioux Falls, S.D. – The North Central Conference announced their weekly swimmers and divers of the week today, Nov. 21, and St. Cloud State junior diver Ross Eiden (Rosemount) was named NCC male diver of the week.

The honor is the second for Eiden already this season and comes on the heels of yet another first place finish, and national qualifying score. In the Huskies dual meet with North Dakota in Grand Forks on Nov. 17, Eiden took top honors on the one-meter board with a score of 272.70, beating the national qualifying mark of 270. The junior also claimed a third place finish in three-meter diving in the meet. Eiden already stamped his ticket to the national meet in both diving events during the first meet this season when he bettered both qualifying marks on Oct. 27, against UW-Eau Claire, and UW-Stevens Point.

Eiden has already been a National meet participant for St. Cloud State, and has been named All-American as well.

The Huskies are off from competition this weekend but will resume action Nov. 30 when the swimmers head to Kenosha Wis. for the TYR/CollegeSwimming.com Classic and on Dec. 1 when the Divers host the Husky Diving Invite in Halenbeck Hall.
