Kendra Willis Honored By NCC:

Sioux Falls, S.D. – The North Central Conference announced their weekly swimmers and divers of the week today, Nov. 21, and St. Cloud State senior diver Kendra Willis (Neenah, Wis.) was named NCC female diver of the week.

Willis claims her first diver of the week honor in 2007-08 after an outstanding performance in the Huskies recent dual meet with the University of North Dakota. On Nov. 17, the senior captured first place honors on the one-meter board with her score of 250.90, which was five points better than the 245 national standard. Also at the meet Willis garnered a runner-up finish in three-meter diving. By making the qualifying standard Willis will now be a NCAA championship meet participant in both diving events as she already qualified for Nationals in three-meter diving on Oct. 27 this season with a 259.45 mark in a meet with UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point.

Willis has already been a National meet participant for St. Cloud State, and just last season was named All-American in one-meter diving.

The Huskies are off from competition this weekend but will resume action Nov. 30 when the swimmers head to Kenosha Wis. for the TYR/CollegeSwimming.com Classic and on Dec. 1 when the Divers host the Husky Diving Invite in Halenbeck Hall.

St. Cloud State University is a member is the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnSCU) system.
