HUSKIES HEAD TO GRAND FORKS THIS WEEK: The SCSU men's and women's swimming and diving teams will head to Grand Forks, ND on Wednesday, February 21 for day-one of the North Central Conference Championships. At the conference meet last year the men's team placed second, breaking a twelve-year streak of

third place finishes and the women finished in third for the third year in a row.

TWELVE ALREADY QUALIFIED FOR NATIONALS: Twelve athletes, three men and nine women, have already qualified themselves for the NCAA National Championships by surpassing the national standard.



Nate Jimerson

Nate Jimerson of Apple Valley has qualified in all four diving events. On November 4, 2006 at the SCSU Invite he qualified for the 11-dive, one-meter scoring 450.55, the six-dive, three-meter with a total of 311.95 points, and the 11-dive, three-meter with a score of 460.45. Then on January 27, 2007 at the UND Invite he not only qualified for nationals on the six-dive, one-meter with a score of 302.25, but he also set a new school record.



Matt Verwey

Red Deer, Alberta native Matt Verwey has qualified for three events. On December 2, 2006 at the TYR Classic in Kenosha, WI he beat the national standard in the 200 IM with a time of 1:56.26 and qualified for the 200 back with a time of 1:54.14. In the 400 IM he swam a 4:06.80, qualifying him for nationals and beating his previous school record of 4:08.43 set on November 17, 2006.



Ross Eiden

On October 28, 2006 at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Ross Eiden of Rosemount qualified for the six-dive, one-meter by posting a point total of 279.20.



Kayla Edelbrock

Three female divers have qualified for two events. On January 27, 2006 at the UND Invite Kayla Edelbrock of St. Cloud qualified for both the six-dive, one-meter with a point total of 253.30 and the six-dive, three meter scoring 258.95.



Kelsey Berkland

Kelsey Berkland of Coon Rapids qualified for the six-dive, three-meter at the first meet of the season held on October 20, 2006 in Marquette, MI. There she posted a point total of 277.45. Then on January 27, 2007 at the UND Invite she qualified for the six-dive, one-meter scoring 267.30.



Kendra Willis

Kendra Willis of Neenah, WI qualified for the six-dive, one-meter at the Northern Michigan Dual held October 20-21, 2006. She beat the national standard by scoring 257.15 points. On November 4, 2006 at the SCSU Invite, she qualified for the ten-dive, one-meter by scoring 381.15.



Sarah Burnell

Oshkosh, WI native Sarah Burnell beat the qualifying mark in the 1650-free on December 1-2, 2006 in Kenosha, WI finishing at 17:59.14.



Katie Brueggemann

Grafton, WI native Katie Brueggemann qualified twice at the TYR Classic in Kenosha, WI on December 1-2, 2006. She beat the standard in the 200 IM by swimming a 2:11.01 and then qualified in the 400 IM with a time of 4:39.81.



Kelly Vieau

Delano native Kelly Vieau swam a 24.81 in the 50-free on November 17-19, 2006 at the Minnesota Invite qualifying her for the national meet.



Brenda Peters

On November 17-19, 2006 Brenda Peters of Faribault qualified for the 50-free by swimming a 24.51. Then on December 1-2, 2006 at the TYR Classic in Kenosha, WI she surpassed the national standard in the 100-free by swimming a 54.03.



Alison Weske

On December 1-2, 2006 at the TYR Classic in Kenosha, WI Alison Weske of Sun Prairie, WI qualified in the 100-fly by swimming a 58.47.



Alisha Blaydes

Alisha Blaydes of Elk River has qualified in the 50-free by swimming a 24.68 at the Minnesota Invite on November 17-19, 2006.

In swimming, beating the standard time guarantees the individual a spot if they are a member of a national qualifying relay team.

Coach Hegle

SCSU HEAD COACH JEFF HEGLE TAKES ON HIS SIXTH YEAR WITH THE HUSKIES: Jeff Hegle returns to the deck for his sixth season as the head swimming and diving coach for the men's and women's programs at St. Cloud State University.

In his five seasons with the Huskies he has led the women's team to top 20 finishes at the NCAA Championships. In both 2006 and 2005, the women placed 12th, and 11th in 2004, 13th in 2003, and 16th in 2002. The men finished 19th in 2006 and 21st at both the 2005 and 2004 NAAs.

Last year the at the North Central Conference Championships, the women place third for the third straight season and the men finally broke a four-year streak of third place finishes by placing second. This was the best finish by the SCSU men's swimming and diving team since 1989.

Hegle is a familiar name to SCSU athletics, as he was a graduate assistant coach to the swimming and diving program for two seasons (1993-95) and is a former Husky swimmer. Hegle captained the SCSU men's swimming and diving team during the 1991-92 season. He received an undergraduate degree in social studies and secondary education in 1993. He earned a master's degree in special education at SCSU.

At St. Cloud State, Hegle was an Admissions Ambassador for three years and a University Award of Excellence in Leadership nominee.

From 1997 until his appointment at SCSU, Hegle had been the girls swim coach at Monticello High School. He joined the Monticello program in 1995 as the assistant swim coach for boys and girls. He has also coached the Monticello Swim Club.

Along with his duties as head swimming and diving coach, Hegle also works in the SCSU Compliance Office.

Hegle, a native of Melrose, Minn., is married to former SCSU volleyball standout Christin Broich. Together they have three daughters, Caitlin, Tessa, and Molly.
