HUSKIES HEAD TO UW-STEVENS POINT: The St. Cloud State University men's and women's swimming and diving teams will head to Stevens Points, Wisc., on Saturday, Oct. 28, to participate in the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point Dual at 2:00 p.m. This dual meet marks the season-opening meet for the Husky men's team.

LAST WEEK FOR THE WOMEN: Led by sophomore diver Kelsey Berkeland (Coon Rapids), who qualified for nationals on both the one-meter and three-meter boards at Northern Michigan last weekend on Oct. 20-21, the Husky women's swimming and diving team tallied 21 first place finishes in its season-opening dual meet in Marquette, Mich. Berkeland tallied scores of 246.05 and 256.9 on the one-meter board and 257.15 and 242.05 on the three-meter board.

JIMERSON PICKED TO LEAD HUSKY MEN: SCSU's sophomore diver Nate Jimerson (Apple Valley) returns to the 2006-07 Husky squad after tallying the best individual performance by a male swimmer or diver in the history of the SCSU program with two second place finishes at the 2006 NCAA Division II National Tournament as a first year. Jimerson opened the competition with a second place finish on the one-meter board with a score of 449.40 and completed the national meet placing second on the three-meter board with a mark of 446.80. His efforts earned him two-time All-America honors.

2005-06 TEAM RESULTS: The St. Cloud State women's swimming and diving team placed 12th with 131 points at the 2006 NCAA Division II Swimming and Diving National Championships, March 8-11 in Indianapolis, Indiana, while the men's SCSU team placed 19th with 52 points. Of note, the women's team finish last season ties the third best finish for SCSU since the 1991 season. The best finish for an SCSU team was fifth in 2000, followed by 11th place finishes in 1994 and 2004. Also, the 131 points was the second highest team total for the SCSU women behind 259 points tallied in 2000.

SCSU HEAD COACH JEFF HEGLE: Jeff Hegle returns to the deck for his sixth season as the head swimming and diving coach for the men's and women's programs at St. Cloud State University in 2006-07. In his five seasons with the Huskies, he has led the women's team to four top 16 finishes at the NCAA Championships. In 2005, the SCSU women placed 12th at the NAAs, 11th in 2004, 13th in 2003, and 16th in 2002. The men's team has placed third at the North Central Conference Championships from 2001-04 and finished in second place in 2005, marking the best finish since 1989. In 2004, Hegle was voted the NCC Men's Swimming Coach of the Year. In addition to his duties as head swimming and diving coach, Hegle is the Aquatics Director at SCSU. Hegle, a native of Melrose, Minn., is married to former SCSU volleyball stand-out Christin Broich and they have three daughters; Caitlin, Tessa and Molly.

ASSISTANT COACHES:

ASSISTING IN 2006-07: Nate Brisley, a former Husky All-American diver, will serve as the diving coach with the SCSU program in 2006-07. Originally from Excelsior, Minn., Brisley began his Husky career in 1999. While competing for the Huskies, he twice earned All-American honors. He then transferred to Drury University where he continued his successful diving career. At Drury, he earned six All-American titles, including a National Championship on the three-meter board, and a team title. In 2004, Brisley was named the NCAA Division II Male Diver of the Year. He graduated from Drury in 2004 with a degree in business administration. While at St. Cloud State, he is pursuing a master's degree in sports administration. Also assisting head coach Jeff Hegle this season is **Charlie King**. King, a former Husky swimmer and 2000 graduate of St. Cloud State University, returns for his second season as a graduate assistant coach with the Huskies in 2006-07. Hegle will also be assisted by three student coaches; **Danielle Breunig, Jackie Vieau and Nick Rosier.**
