SCSU SWIMMING & DIVING INVITATIONAL ON DECK: The annual St. Cloud State University Swimming and Diving Invitational will be held Saturday, November 6 at Halenbeck Pool on the St. Cloud State campus. The morning session will begin at 10:30 a.m. Diving is scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m. and the evening session will begin at 6:30 p.m.

COMPETING TEAMS: The SCSU men's and women's team will entertain teams from Minnesota State University, Mankato, Minnesota State University, Moorhead, Morningside College, Gustavus Adolphus College, and the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

SCSU HEAD COACH: Jeff Hagle (St. Cloud State, 1993) begins his fourth season as the head men's and women's swimming and diving coach. In his three seasons with the Huskies he has led both the women's team to top 20 finishes at the NCAA Championships. In 2004, the SCSU women placed 11th at the NCAAs, 13th in 2003, and 16th in 2002. The men finished 21st at the 2004 NCAAs. Under his tutelage the men's team has placed third at the North Central Conference Championships in each of the last three seasons. In 2004, Hagle was voted the NCC Men's Swimming Coach of the Year. Hagle swam for the Huskies in the early 90s and was a team captain. This season he is assisted by Anthony Harris and Steve Mohs. SCSU's diving coach is Nate Brisley.

LAST WEEK: The St. Cloud State women's swimming and diving team posted a weekend sweep of duals at Northern Michigan University. On Friday, the Huskies defeated the Wildcats 174-69 and Saturday downed NMU 161-78.

On Friday, SCSU won 11 of 13 events in the dual, led by junior Jackie Vieau who won the 200 freestyle in 1:58.09 and the 100 freestyle in :54.64. Senior Tennyson Anseth won the 1000 free in 11:06.80, sophomore Brenda Peters won the 50 free in :25.29; junior Alise Emil won the 100 fly in 1:01.75, junior Kristin Otterson won the 100 back in 1:03.13, first year Laura Seidenkranz won the 500 free in 5:27.08, first year Melissa Eggleston won the 100 breast in 1:10.79, and junior sara Steffen won the three-meter diving with a score of 272.25. The 200 medley relay and 200 free relay also gained medalist honors.

Saturday, the Huskies also won 10 of the events, with Vieau winning the 200 free in 1:59.60 and the 500 free in 5:27.83. Junior Danielle Breunig also won two events, taking home first in the 50 free in :25.40 and the 100 free in :54.33.
