## 2006 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

**HUSKIES HOME ON THE RANGE:** St. Cloud State Universities men's tennis team will be coming home for their first time this season to compete across divisions to face off against their rivals, St. John's University on Thursday, Feb. 16. The match-up will be held at Gold's Gym in Sartell, Minn., play beginning at 2:30 p.m.

**HUSKIES SPLIT AT MICHIGAN TECH:** The St. Cloud State men's tennis team suffered their first loss of the season at Michigan Tech. on Feb. 11 to Lake Superior State but picked up another win to tally on their fourth win last Saturday.

The first test of the trip was against Michigan Tech. where each of the Huskies picked up a victory with their first team sweep of the season. The tougher competition came later in the day when they had to face off against a very experienced LSSU. Lake Superior State led after the singles matches, 4-2 but SCSU came back winning the no.1 and no.2 doubles matches tying the score. The decision came down to Kevin Lukens and Kris Johnson who faced off against Geoff Markoson and Jonathon Lejac-Goulet. LSSU took the first set 8-9 but due to the score they faced off again in the tie breaker set but the Husky duo was taken down 2-7 marking LSSU the victor.

Tony Larson continued his undefeated streak, now 5-0 in the no. 1 slot. Larson barreled over the MTU ace Brett Groth 6-0, 6-4 and won the first match-up against LSSU's Luda Marruet-Damers 6-4, 6-3. He was also victorious in doubles matches, increasing Jachymowski and his record to 5-0 beating MSU 8-3, and LSSU 8-4. Micheal Engdahl suffered his first loss at the no.2 singles slot against Tomyoki Fukishina of LSSU in two tie breaker sets 7-6(4-6), 6-7(4-7). Engdahl did chart another victory over MTU's Borkadi 6-1,6-0. Joey Jachymowski, who usually is the no.4 singles challenger, was slotted at the no.3 spot this weekend wining 6-4,6-2 over MTU and losing 4-6, 2-6 to LSSU, tallying his record to 1-1 in both no.2 and no.3 singles matches. Johnson was the only other Husky to go 2-0 in singles play, winning 6-2,6-2 and 6-1,6-2 over MTU and LSSU respectively. Dan Boulay and Lukens both went 1-1 in singles matches this weekend. The Engdahl and Boulay duo were also victors in their doubles matches this weekend at the no.2 slot wining 8-1 over MTU and 8-3 over LSSU. Lukens and Johnson took the no.3 duo from MTU 8-3 in no.3 doubles.

**TEAM NOTES:** SCSU's 12 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won four consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Last year, the Huskies won their first-ever regional match with a 5-2 victory against Colorado University-Colorado Springs in a match played at St. Cloud...SCSU swept the NCC tournament last year, winning first place at every flight. Returning champs include Tony Larson (#1 singles/#1 doubles), Michael Engdahl (#3 singles/#3 doubles), Travis Marohl (#4 singles), Joey Jachymowski (#5 singles/#1 doubles), Dan Boulay (#6 singles/#3 doubles).

**COACHING STAFF:** Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006.



Anderson owns a 145-62 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
