2006 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

HUSKIES HOST RIVAL NORTH DAKOTA: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team will host their NCC rivals from Grand Forks, N.D., on Friday, Feb. 17 at 1:30 p.m. at Gold's Gym in Sartell, Minn. This will be the third NCC match-up of the season for the Huskies sitting at 1-1 in conference play. North Dakota is currently 4-2 overall and 3-1 in the NCC.

HUSKIES EARN TWO SWEEPS AND SUFFER ONE LOSS: The Husky women's tennis team collected their first and second sweeps of the season on the 11th and 12th of February, against Moorhead State and Southwest State, after tallying a loss to Winona on the 10th.

Winona State took all but two singles matches against SCSU and won the final doubles match to complete their 5-4 victory over the Huskies. Kim Lindblom was slotted in no.1 singles for the first time this season but lost her first match in the top spot to Michele Bailey 6-2, 6-3. Kristie Eull and Laura Klien were the only Huskies to win their singles matches in the no.4 and no.6 slots respectively. Lindblom and Kelley Severson won their tie breaking match in their no.1 doubles match, 8-8 (9-7). Eull and Klien teamed up for the first time this season in doubles winning the no.2 doubles match 8-3.

Severson took over her no.1 singles slot against Moorhead State, picking up her first win of the season in the top slot, and started off the winning streak for the team's first sweep of the season, she won 6-1, 6-3. Lindblom followed 6-0, 6-2 over Schaferin no.2 singles. The no.1 duo, Severson-Lindblom, tallied their second win of the season 8-3 over MSU's top pair Milless and DiCorveani. First year Katie Casper made her debut in the no.6 slot against Marie Caderberg winning 6-4, 6-1.

Lindblom got her chance to test out the drivers seat at no.1 singles on Feb. 12 versus Southwest Minnesota State. She competed against Sarah Hildebrandt who gave her a run for her money, playing three sets 4-6, 6-1, 1-0; Lindblom taking her first win at the top slot. Nicole Towne won her first singles match as a Husky in the no.6 slot over Jamie Engen 6-2, 6-1. Casper played her first doubles match against Southwest, teamed up with Katie Harrison tallying a victory in no.3 doubles 8-1. Lindblom and Severson extended their record to 3-3 in the no.1 doubles slot, along with Eull and Klien who finished the weekend 3-0 in no.2 doubles.

The Huskies finished the weekend 2-1 overall, 8-4 in singles matches, and 8-1 in doubles matches. The extended their season record to 3-3. Eull was the only Husky to win 3 singles and 3 doubles matches this weekend. Klien took home victories in all of her matches, playing in one singles match and three doubles matches.



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 1st season as the SCSU women's tennis head coach in 2006, and continues as the men's tennis head coach in his 9th season with the Huskies. As the men's coach, his squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
