2006 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

HUSKIES TO HOST THREE MATCHES: St. Cloud State Universities men's tennis team (8-1) will be back home at the Gold's Gym Tennis Center in Sartell this week. It will be their last match before the Huskies' Spring Break trip for matches in California. It will be on Mar. 4 and SCSU will host St. Scholastica.

HUSKIES SWEEP WEEKEND: Over this past weekend the Huskies had three impressive wins over non conference opponents. The first was a 9-0 win against Bethel College. Tony Larson posted a 6-2, 6-2 win at #1 singles. Michael Engdahl rolled to a 6-2, 6-4 win at #2 singles and Travis Marohl won a 6-1, 6-2 decision at #3 singles. Joey Jachymowski gained a 6-3, 6-2 win at #4 singles and Sabastian Alderstein collected a 7-5, 6-1 win at #5. To complete the sweep, Kevin Lukens carded a 6-3, 6-1 win at #6 singles. In doubles play, Larson and Jachymowski won 8-0 at #1 and Engdahl and Marohl posted an 8-0 win at #2 doubles. Lukens and Johnson added an 8-5 win at #3 doubles. Next the Huskies defeated Augustana 8-1. Tony Larson gained a 6-0, 6-1 win at #1 singles. Michael Engdahl won 6-4, 2-6 (10-6) at #2 singles and Travis Marohl added a 6-2, 6-0 win at #3 singles. At #4 singles, Joey Jackymowski won 6-4, 6-4 and then Sebastian Adlerstein posted a 6-0, 6-1 win at #5 singles. Dan Boulay also posted a 6-1, 6-0 win at #6 singles. In doubles play, SCSU's Larson and Jackymowski won 8-6 at #1 doubles and Lukens and Johnson rolled to an 8-0 win at #3 doubles. Finally the Huskies beat Hamline with a score of 8-1. Tony Larson charted a 6-1, 6-1 win at #1 singles and Michael Engdahl won 6-1, 6-0 at #2 singles. At #3 singles, Marohl posted a 7-6 (7-0), 6-3 win and at #4 singles Joey Jackymowski won 6-1, 6-4. Next, SCSU's Dan Boulay won 6-1, 6-2 at #6 singles. At #1 doubles Larson and Jackymowski won 8-2 and Engdahl and Marohl chalked up a 8-5 win at #2 doubles. Finally at #3 doubles Johnson and Lukens won a close match with a score of 9-7.

TEAM NOTES: Tony Larson is 9-0 in singles play, and he is 9-0 at first doubles along with partner Joey Jachymowski. SCSU's other doubles tandem is Travis Marohl and Michael Engdahl at #2 doubles with a 6-1 record, while Engdahl and Dan Boulay are 2-0 at #2 doubles this season...SCSU's 12 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won four consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Last year, the Huskies won their first-ever regional match with a 5-2 victory against Colorado University-Colorado Springs in a match played at St. Cloud...SCSU swept the NCC tournament last year, winning first place at every flight. Returning champs include Tony Larson (#1 singles/#1 doubles), Michael Engdahl (#3 singles/#3 doubles), Travis Marohl (#4 singles), Joey Jachymowski (#5 singles/#1 doubles), Dan Boulay (#6 singles/#3 doubles).



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006. Anderson owns a 149-62 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
