Huskies Win 2006 NCC Championship

The Huskies won their 13th North Central Conference title in 2006. The Huskies captured league titles at four singles and all three doubles positions. Grabbing titles for the Huskies were Tony Larson at #1, Joey Jachymowski at #4 singles, Sebastain Adlerstein at #5 singles, and Kevin Lukens at #6 singles. In doubles competition, the Huskies' number one team of Larson and Jachymowski were the champs and the number two team of Travis Marohl and Mike Engdahl were also champs. To complete the title parade, Lukens and Kris Johnson won honors at #3 doubles. SCSU won the title with 33 points, while Winona State was second at 26. Augustana (21) and Minnesota State Mankato (11) completed the field.

SCSU Coach Profile



Head Coach Jerry Anderson

St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 10th season with the Huskies in 2007. In his first two years at SCSU, Anderson directed the Huskies to first place finishes in the North Central Conference and has also gained NCC titles in 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 and

2006. SCSU placed second in the always rugged NCC in 2001 and Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 163-66. In 2002, SCSU set a new team record for dual meet wins at 24-7, and also qualified for the NCAA Division II regional tournament. Of note, the Huskies have gained six consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2006, 2005, 2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). Last year, SCSU was 1-1 in NCAA regional play.

A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. At Willmar Community College, Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA national championships in 1981.

Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification.

He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.

SCSU Assistant Coaches



Assistant Coach Larry Sundby

Larry Sundby begins his second-season as an assistant coach at SCSU, after serving for 18 seasons as the women's head coach. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 311-129 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988,

1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Sundby is in his 28th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis head coach, his teams compiled a 442-172 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992.

Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University.



Assistant Coach Scott Johnson

Scott Johnson has brought valuable experience to the SCSU tennis program over the past few years. As a volunteer coach, Johnson works in the areas of singles and doubles strategy, stroke development and

practice drilling. Johnson is a faculty member in the College of Business.



Assistant Coach Tony Larson

A two-year standout on the SCSU men's tennis team from 2005-2006, Larson will serve as an assistant coach this spring. At SCSU, Larson won NCC titles at #1 singles and #1 doubles and was ranked nationally

last spring by the ITA in singles. An Academic All-America award winner as a senior, Larson was 48-3 during his singles career at SCSU.
