## 2009 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

**THE SEASON WRAP:** The SCSU women's tennis team completed its season with a 26-9 overall record and a 13-1 record in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. The Huskies captured first place at the 2009 NSIC team tournament, and they also showed well at the 2009 NSIC Individual tournament, as the Huskies earned first place finishes at 2nd singles, 3rd singles, 4th singles, 6th singles, 2nd doubles and 3rd doubles. SCSU set a team record for most wins in a season at 26. For their efforts, the Huskies earned an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament bid. SCSU was ranked among the top two teams in the final NCAA regional poll this season, and they hosted play in the first/second rounds of the NCAA Division II Regional at nearby Sartell H.S. SCSU fell in the second round of play by a 5-4 score to MSU-Billings after earning a first round bye.



**COACHING STAFF:** Coach Jerry Anderson is in his 4th season as the SCSU women's tennis head coach in 2008, and continues as the men's tennis head coach in his 11th season with the Huskies. He owns a 72-37 dual record as head coach of the women's tennis team at SCSU. His women's team at SCSU won the 2009 NSIC championship and it also gained an NCAA tournament bid in 2009. As the men's coach, his squads won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. Assistant coaches for the Huskies include Larry Sundby, Scott Johnson and Mark Muntifering.

**TEAM NOTES AND NEWS:** SCSU ran off 17 consecutive dual match wins to cap a strong finish in 2009. The streak was snapped with a tough 5-4 loss to MSU-Billings in the NCAA tournament. SCSU's 26 wins this season marks a team record, with the previous season-high of 21 victories coming in 2003, 2002 and 1999...this marked SCSU's first ever NSIC title, and it came in the team's first year in the NSIC. SCSU also won conference titles in 1991, 1990, 1987 and 1985 as members of the former North Central Conference. SCSU also won league titles in the old Northern Sun Conference for Women in 1983, 1982, 1981 and 1980...plenty of records were broken by the Huskies in 2009. Kelly Freese and Kayla Lenz set team records for singles wins in a season with 31 apiece. Kristie Eull tied a team record for doubles wins in a season with 26, while Freese set a team record with 56 combined wins (singles/doubles) in 2009. In the career category, Freese has already set a team record for career singles wins at 82 (in just three seasons). She has also set a team record with 146 career wins (combined singles/doubles). Eull also finished her sterling career at SCSU with 216 matches played (combined singles/doubles), which also sets a new team standard.

**NCAA TOURNAMENT:** SCSU hosted the NCAA DII Central regional on May 8-9 at the Sartell High School. In first round play, Montana State-Billings posted a 5-3 win over Minnesota State Mankato on May 8. In the second round play, MSU-Billings advanced to the NCAA finals with a 5-4 victory over host St. Cloud State University on May 9. This was SCSU's fifth trip to the NCAA tournament, and the team's first appearance in tournament play since 2005. Of note, SCSU advanced in tournament play in the AIAW nationals during the 1980, 1981 and 1982 seasons. This marked the first time SCSU has hosted tournament play in the NCAA tournament.

**NEW CONFERENCE:** The Huskies began play in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in 2009. The conference teams include Augustana, Bemidji State, Minnesota State-Mankato, Minnesota State-Moorhead, Northern State, Upper Iowa, Winona State, Minnesota-Crookston, U-Mary, SCSU and Southwest Minnesota State. SCSU won the NSIC title in 2009.
