2006 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: March 15, 2006



HUSKIES BACK HOME: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team will take a brief break before returning to action on March 24 with a home match against Minnesota State, Mankato. On March 25, the Huskies will host Winona State. Both matches will take place at the Gold's Gym Tennis Center in nearby Sartell. SCSU currently owns a 12-2 overall record.

HUSKIES STRIKE GOLD IN CALIFORNIA: The Huskies enjoyed a strong showing during their recent spring break trip to California. SCSU posted a 3-1 record out west and also saw its match scheduled against Sonoma State rained out. The Huskies opened the week with a home victory at the Gold's Gym Tennis Center with a 9-0 win over St. Scholastica on March 4. Out west, SCSU carded a 5-4 win over Westmont College on March 4. On March 8, the Huskies gained an 8-1 win over Cal Poly Pomona and on March 9, the Huskies gained a 9-0 win over Western New Mexico in a match played at Palm Desert, Calif. SCSU completed the trip with a 7-2 loss to Ventura College on March 10. SCSU now owns a 12-2 record this season.

TEAM NOTES: Tony Larson is 14-0 in singles play, and he is 13-1 at first doubles along with partner Joey Jachymowski. Larson had a homecoming of sorts with his return to Westmont College. He played there for two seasons before transferring to SCSU last year. He gained a 6-4, 6-4 win over Westmont's Burke Marold on March 7. He also notched a 6-3, 6-7, 10-3 win over Ventura's Walter Lima to close out the trip. At #2 singles, Michael Engdahl is 12-2, with his lone loss on the trip coming against Ventura College - the fourth ranked team in the California Community College rankings this season...on the subject of rankings, SCSU owns a fifth place ranking in the first regional poll of the season released by the ITA. Northwest Missouri State is ranked first, while UN-Kearney is second, Washburn third and Southwest Baptist is fourth...of note, Lake Superior State (SCSU's only loss to a DII opponent this season) is ranked 7th in the Great Lakes Region...SCSU's 12 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won four consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Last year, the Huskies won their first-ever regional match with a 5-2 victory against Colorado University-Colorado Springs in a match played at St. Cloud... SCSU swept the NCC tournament last year, winning first place at every flight. Returning champs include Tony Larson (#1 singles/#1 doubles), Michael Engdahl (#3 singles/#3 doubles), Travis Marohl (#4 singles), Joey Jachymowski (#5 singles/#1 doubles), Dan Boulay (#6 singles/#3 doubles).



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006. Anderson owns a 153-63 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
