2005 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: March 22, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team (14-5) will host the Gold's Gym Invitational on April 2, at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell, Minn. SCSU will open play with a match against St. Scholastica at Noon, followed by a 1:30 p.m. match between St. Benedict's and Bemidji State. At 3 p.m., St. Scholastica and St. Ben's will square off, and at 4:30 p.m., the Huskies will play Bemidji State. At 6 p.m., St. Scholastica will play Bemidji State, and at 7:30 p.m., the Huskies and St. Ben's will complete this day of tennis action in Sartell.

HUSKIES GO 3-0 LAST WEEK: It was a great weekend for the Huskies as they charted a 3-0 record with wins against Wiona State (7-2) on March 19, Augustana (8-1) on March 20 and Metro State (9-0) on March 21. In play against Winona State (ranked eighth in the latest region poll), the Huskies (ranked #5 in the latest region poll) were down 2-1 after doubles play. SCSU responded with six wins in singles action led by Nicole Lechner at #1 singles, Sara Eull at #2, Kelley Severson at #3, Kim Lindblom at #4, Jenna Vogel at #5 and Alyssa Achman at #6. Lechner and Severson also posted an 8-5 win at #1 doubles. Against Augustana, the Huskies only lost at #1 singles, as they went on to win 8-1 against their NCC rival. Vogel collected a 7-6, 7-6 thriller against Augustana's Mallory Larsen at #4 singles, while Katie Harrison and Casie Siekman also posted a tough 9-8 win at #3 doubles. To end the weekend, SCSU blanked visiting Metro State by a 9-0 tally. Lindblom highlighted the day with a perfect 6-0, 6-0 win at #4 singles, and an 8-0 win at #3 doubles along with partner Vogel.

TEAM NOTES: The Huskies received a #5 ranking in the latest regional released by the ITA. The doubles team of Lechner and Severson was also ranked eighth in the regional polls released by the ITA... Kim Lindblom is still undefeated in singles this season with a perfect 16-0 record (9-0 at #5, 5-0 at #4 and 2-0 at #3)...Jenna Vogel ranks second on the team with a 13-5 singles record...SCSU's #1 doubles team of Lechner and Severson is 14-4 this year...Lechner and Sara Eull have been designated as team captains in 2005...SCSU gained its second consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bid in 2004. Overall, SCSU has been invited to the NCAA tournament three times. The other trip to the NCAAs was in 1995...both Lechner and Eull have notched over 100 career wins at SCSU...SCSU posted its 17th consecutive winning season in 2004, which featured an 18-7 record. At the NCC championships, the Huskies placed third behind first place UND and runner-up Nebraska-Omaha...fans, mark April 22-23 on your calendars since that is when the Huskies will host the 2005 North Central Conference championships at Gold's Gym. The tournament will be making a return to St. Cloud for the first time in over two seasons.

COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State women's tennis coach Larry Sundby begins his 18th season with the Huskies in 2005. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 307-125 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988, 1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby has also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003 and 2004. Sundby is in his 27th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis coach, his teams have compiled a 435-168 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992. Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University. He is assisted this year by Scott Johnson and Mark Muntifering.
