2006 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 13, 2006



LOOKING FOR NUMBER FIVE: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (19-4), which is ranked third in the latest NCAA Division II North Central Region poll and fifth in the region in the latest ITA poll, will travel to the 2006 North Central Conference championships in Grand Forks, N.D. on April 20. SCSU will be looking to win its fifth consecutive NCC championship and the team's 13th NCC title since 1986. No other sport at SCSU has won as many NCC championships as the men's tennis team. Coach Jerry Anderson has won six NCC crowns during his storied career with the Huskies since 1998.

HUSKIES WARM UP FOR NCC CHAMPIONSHIPS: SCSU warmed up for the upcoming NCC championships with four matches last week. On April 5, the Huskies made quick work of Stearns County rival St. John's with a 9-0 win in Collegeville. On April 7, SCSU gained a huge 5-4 win over Northwest Missouri State (which was ranked #2 in the region ahead of #3 SCSU). In doubles play, the Huskies #1 team of Tony Larson and Joey Jachymowski won 8-6 and the #2 doubles team of Michael Engdahl and Travis Marohl won 8-6. At #3 doubles, Kevin Lukens and Kris Johnson rolled to an 8-3 win. To ice the win, Larson won 6-2, 6-0 at #1 singles and Marohl posted a 7-6, 6-7, 7-5 win at #3 singles. On April 8, SCSU dropped an 8-1 loss at Gustavus Adolphus (the nation's #1 ranked DIII team). Larson was the lone winner with a 6-0, 6-0 triumph at #1 singles over GAC's Jesse Brauer. To end the busy week, the Huskies posted a 7-2 win over NCC rival Minnesota State Mankato on April 8, in a match played at the indoor courts in St. Peter.

TEAM NOTES: In the most recent ITA national poll, Tony Larson (22-1 in singles play this season) ranks 45rd. He is ranked third in the region. In doubles, Larson and Joey Jachymowski ranked eighth in the region with a 20-3 record at #1 doubles...on the subject of rankings, SCSU owns a fifth place ranking in the April 7 regional poll of the season released by the ITA. In the all-important regional released by the NCAA, the Huskies were ranked third on March 30 behind Washburn and Northwest Missouri State. The win over NWMSU, should helped the Huskies' chances of hosting a regional tournament for the second consecutive year..SCSU's 12 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won four consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Last year, the Huskies won their first-ever regional match with a 5-2 victory against Colorado University-Colorado Springs in a match played at St. Cloud...SCSU swept the NCC tournament last year, winning first place at every flight. Returning champs include Tony Larson (#1 singles/#1 doubles), Michael Engdahl (#3 singles/#3 doubles), Travis Marohl (#4 singles), Joey Jachymowski (#5 singles/#1 doubles), Dan Boulay (#6 singles/#3 doubles).

COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006. Anderson owns a 162-65 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
