### 2006 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 24, 2006



**FINAL MATCH CANCELLED:** The St. Cloud State women's tennis team's (12-10) match on April 25 against the University of Sioux Falls has been cancelled. No make-up date has been scheduled for this match.

**NCC CHAMPIONSHIP RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State University women's tennis team place third at the 2006 North Central Conference Championships on April 21-22. The tournament was held at the Center Court Fitness Club in Grand Forks, N.D. The Huskies posted 44 points, while North Dakota had 48 points and team champion Nebraska-Omaha had 58 points. Minnesota Duluth was fourth with 29 points, while Minnesota State Mankato (27), Augustana (23) and South Dakota (23) completed the field. Jenna Vogel gained her second consecutive NCC singles titles this season with a first place finish at #3 singles. Vogel, who won the top spot at #5 singles last year, charted a 7-6 (9-7), 6-4, 10-8 marathon win over UNO's Maggie Russell. Along the way, Vogel gained a 6-1, 6-1 win over Augie's Katie Bohl and a 6-1, 6-4 win over Mankato's Lindsey Schmidt. SCSU's other champion was Katie Casper at #6 singles. In the title bout at #6 singles, Casper posted a 6-3, 6-2 win over Sarah Lamberty of Augustana. To open play, Casper defeated UMD's Andrea Mock 7-6 (7-2), 6-3 and then defeated UNO's Katie Spahn 6-0, 7-5. SCSU received third place finishes at the tournament from Caitlin Jurgensen at #5 singles and Kelley Severson at #2 singles. SCSU's doubles team of Jurgensen and Kristie Eull placed third at #2 doubles and Vogel and Laura Klein were third at #3 doubles. At fourth singles, Eull placed fourth and Kim Lindblom placed fifth at #1 singles. The #1 doubles squad of Severson and Lindblom placed fifth at the NCC tournament.

**SCSU NOTES:** This marked the second consecutive season that SCSU has placed third at the NCC championships...SCSU has finished no lower than fourth place at the conference tournament since the Huskies joined the NCC in 1985...SCSU has qualified for the NCAA regional tournament in 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU also gained an NCAA bid in 1995... long-time head coach Larry Sundby stepped down at SCSU in 2005. He charted a 311-129 record during his 18 seasons at SCSU. This season he will serve as an assistant coach to Jerry Anderson for both the men's and women's programs...several Central Minnesota athletes are on the women's tennis team at SCSU this season. Those include St. Cloud's Kelley Severson, Foley's Nicole Towne, St. Michael's Kristie Eull and Staples Jenna Vogel and Jacquelyn Peterson...Coach Anderson completed his first year as the women's tennis team coach at SCSU with a 12-10 dual match record.



**COACHING STAFF:** Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 1st season as the SCSU women's tennis head coach in 2006, and continues as the men's tennis head coach in his 9th season with the Huskies. As the men's coach, his squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
