2005 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 4, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team (15-7) will be on the road this week. On April 6, the Huskies will play at Minnesota State, Moorhead and on April 8, the Huskies will travel to Nebraska-Omaha for a key NCC showdown.

HUSKIES EDGE BEMIDJI 5-0: The St. Cloud State University women's tennis team charted a 1-2 record during its SCSU-CSB Invitational on April 2, at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in nearby Sartell. The teams involved in the meet included Bemidji State, St. Scholastica and the College of St. Benedict. Of note, each dual match consisted of just five matches (three singles and two doubles matches and players were allowed to only play singles or doubles). To open the day, SCSU lost a 3-2 decision to St. Scholastica. Sara Eull posted a 6-2, 2-6, 1-0 win at #1 singles and Kim Lindblom won 6-3, 2-6, 1-0 at #3 singles. The Huskies rebounded with a 5-0 win over Bemidji State, in the second match of the day. Nicole Lechner (#1), Alyssa Achman (#2) and Kelley Severson (#3) all won matches in singles play. In doubles action, Eull and Laura Klein went 6-1, 6-1 at #1 doubles. At #3 doubles, Jenna Vogel and Lindblom won 6-3, 6-2. To end the day, the Huskies dropped a tough 4-1 decision to St. Ben's. Lindblom was SCSU's lone winner with a 7-6, 2-6, 1-0 decision at #2 singles.

TEAM NOTES: The Huskies received a #5 ranking in the latest regional released by the ITA. the doubles team of Lechner and Severson was also ranked eighth in the regional polls released by the ITA... Kim Lindblom is still undefeated in singles this season with a perfect 16-0 record (9-0 at #5, 5-0 at #4 and 2-0 at #3)...Jenna Vogel ranks second on the team with a 13-5 singles record...SCSU's #1 doubles team of Lechner and Severson is 14-4 this year...Lechner and Sara Eull have been designated as team captains in 2005...SCSU gained its second consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bid in 2004. Overall, SCSU has been invited to the NCAA tournament three times. The other trip to the NAAs was in 1995...both Lechner and Eull have notched over 100 career wins at SCSU...SCSU posted its 17th consecutive winning season in 2004, which featured an 18-7 record. At the NCC championships, the Huskies placed third behind first place UND and runner-up Nebraska-Omaha...fans, mark April 22-23 on your calendars since that is when the Huskies will host the 2005 North Central Conference championships at Gold's Gym. The tournament will be making a return to St. Cloud for the first time in over two seasons.

COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State women's tennis coach Larry Sundby begins his 18th season with the Huskies in 2005. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 308-127 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988, 1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby has also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003 and 2004. Sundby is in his 27th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis coach, his teams have compiled a 436-170 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992. Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University. He is assisted this year by Scott Johnson and Mark Muntifering.
