Larson won #1 singles and #1 doubles title at 2005 NCC tournament...23-2 singles record and recipient of region's "Player to Watch" award...advanced to semi-finals of ITA regional tournament in fall of 2005...ranked second in region for singles and eighth in doubles head-

Huskies Win 2005 NCC Championship

The Huskies won their 12th North Central Conference title in 2005. The Huskies captured league titles at five singles and all three doubles positions. Grabbing titles for the Huskies were Tony Larson at #1, Titus Christianson at #2 singles, Michael Engdahl at #3 singles, Travis Marohl at #4 singles and Joey Jachymowski at #5 singles. In doubles competition, the Huskies' number one team of Larson and Jachymowski were the champs and the number two team of Christianson and Jeff Horner were also champs. To complete the title parade, Dan Boulay and Engdahl won honors at #3 doubles. SCSU won the title with 35 points, while Winona State was second at 25. Augustana (16) and Minnesota State Mankato (14) completed the field.

SCSU Coach Profile



Head Coach Jerry Anderson

St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006. In his first two years at SCSU, Anderson directed the Huskies to first place finishes in the North Central Conference and has also gained NCC titles in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

SCSU placed second in the always rugged NCC in 2001 and Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 143-61. In 2002, SCSU set a new team record for dual meet wins at 24-7, and also qualified for the NCAA Division II regional tournament. Of note, the Huskies have gained five consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2005, 2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). Last year, SCSU hosted the NCAA regional tournament and posted a 1-1 record.

A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. At Willmar Community College, Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA national championships in 1981.

Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification.

He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.

Assistant Coach Larry Sundby

Larry Sundby begins his first season as an assistant coach at SCSU, after serving the last 18 seasons as the women's head coach at SCSU. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 311-129 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988, 1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby has also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Sundby is in his 28th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis head coach, his teams compiled a 442-172 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992.

Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University.



Assistant Coach Scott Johnson

Scott Johnson has brought valuable experience to the SCSU tennis program over the past few years. As a volunteer coach, Johnson works in the areas of singles and doubles strategy, stroke development and

practice drilling. Johnson is a faculty member in the College of Business.



Assistant Coach Mark Muntifering

Mark Muntifering is the tennis director at Gold's Gym in St. Cloud. He is also the head boys' and girls' tennis coach at St. Cloud Apollo H.S., where he has been recognized as the Minnesota High School "Coach of the

Year" for both teams. He was recently recognized by the Northern Section of the USTA for his community volunteer work in promoting tennis.
