2006 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: 2006 Final Report



HUSKIES END SEASON: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (20-5) finished its 2006 season with a return trip to the NCAA Division II national tournament. In North Central Regional play in Kearney, Neb. on May 5-6, the Huskies posted a 1-1 record. In first round play, #4 seed SCSU charted a 5-2 win over #5 seed Truman State. The win advanced the Huskies to second round play against host Nebraska-Kearney (the #1 seed). On May 6, UN-Kearney eliminated the Huskies from NCAA play with a tough 5-1 loss at Harmon Park in Kearney, Neb. This marked SCSU's sixth consecutive NCAA bid and the second consecutive season that the Huskies have posted a win in first round action. All-time at the NCAA tournament, the Huskies own a 2-6 record...in play against Truman State, SCSU gained doubles wins by Joey Jachymowski and Tony Larson at #1 doubles and Kevin Lukens and Kris Johnson at #3 doubles. In singles play, Larson rolled to a 6-4, 6-0 win at #1 singles, while Michael Engdahl won at #2 singles and Sebastian Adlerstein won at #5 singles to ice the win. Against UNK, the Huskies' lone win came at #2 doubles as Engdahl and Travis Marohl posted an 8-5 win over Andres Espinosa and Luke Backhaus.

MAKE THAT FIVE IN A ROW: The Huskies brought home another addition to their trophy case by winning the 2006 North Central Conference men's tennis championships on April 20 in Grand Forks, N.D. This marked the fifth consecutive season that SCSU has won the NCC title and the 13th time since 1986. This was coach Jerry Anderson's seventh NCC crown since he took over the squad in 1998. SCSU posted 33 points to win the crown, followed by Winona State (26), Augustana (21) and Minnesota State Mankato (11). At #1 singles, Tony Larson defeated Winona's Gage Davidson 6-4, 6-2 for the title, while Joey Jachymowski gained an injury default win over Augustana's Ryan Gardner. At fifth singles, Sebastian Adlerstein defeated Winona's Will Nagel 6-4, 6-1 and Kevin Lukens gained a 2-6, 6-3, 10-8 win over WSU's Ryan Ziika at #6 singles. In doubles play, Larson and Jachymowski won 8-5 over AC's Shanor/Krueger at #1 doubles. Michael Engdahl and Travis Marohl posted a win at #2 doubles against AC's Gardner/Olson. To ice the title, SCSU's Lukens and Kris Johnson rolled to a big 8-1 win at #3 doubles over Holwarth/Miriovsky of Augustana. Of note, SCSU's Michael Engdahl placed third at #2 singles and Travis Marohl placed second at #3 singles.

TEAM NOTES: SCSU's 13 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won five consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005...did you know that Tony Larson completed his 2006 season with a 25-1 record at #1 singles and his career record at SCSU was 48-3...Travis Marohl also completed his career at SCSU this spring with a 15-8 record this spring in singles play, and a 15-6 #2 doubles record...the Huskies will only lose two players from their 2006 squad (Larson and Marohl), while six players are eligible to return next spring - including NCC champs Engdahl, Lukens, Adlerstein, Jachymowski and Johnson.



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 9th season with the Huskies in 2006. Anderson owns a 163-66 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
