HUSKIES SWEEP AUGIE, HAMLIN: The SCSU men's tennis team retained its undefeated record this season with a pair of dual match wins this past weekend. On Feb. 25, the Huskies posted a 9-0 win over Augustana College and a 9-0 win over Hamline University. Both matches were played at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell - the home of SCSU tennis. Tony Larson (at #1 singles), Titus Christianson (at #2 singles), Michael Engdahl (at #3 singles) and Travis Marohl (at #4 singles) all posted wins over Hamline and Augustana. Joey Jachymowski added a #5 singles win over Augustana, and Dan Boulay had a win over Augustana at #6 singles. Boulay also had a win at #5 over Hamline, while Jeff Horner gained a 6-1, 6-1 win at #6 singles over Hamline. In doubles play, Larson and Jachymowski went 2-0 against AC and HU at #1 doubles. Christianson and Horner also gained two wins at #2 doubles this weekend. To complete the sweep, Kevin Lukens and Marohl won at #3 doubles against Augustana and Engdahl and Boulay rolled at #3 doubles against Hamline.

TEAM NOTES: Titus Christianson and Michael Engdahl each own perfect 9-0 records in singles play for the Huskies in 2005. Christianson and Jeff Horner are also unbeaten this year in doubles play with an 8-0 record...in the pre-season Division II regional poll released by the ITA, the Huskies were ranked 7th among North Central Region teams. Titus Christianson was ranked 13th in the poll for singles...Tony Larson, who is playing #1 singles for the Huskies this year, is a transfer from NAIA school Westmont College (Santa Barbara, Calif.). A resident of Long Prairie, Larson played two seasons at Westmont and was nationally ranked in top 50 as a sophomore. Of note, Larson won the MSHSL state singles tournament in 2000...the Huskies won the NCC title in 2004, and they also won every singles and doubles title at the NCC tournament last spring...SCSU will host the 2005 NCC championships at Gold's Gym on April 21-22...SCSU has gained four consecutive NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004...SCSU's 11 NCC titles represent the most NCC crowns won by any team in any sport at SCSU...Titus Christianson won a NCC title at #2 doubles and #2 singles in 2004, while Jeff Horner won a title at #3 doubles.



COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 8th season with the Huskies in 2005. Anderson's teams have won NCC titles in 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 and 2004. Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 130-58. Of note, the Huskies have gained four consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. He graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
